There will be a Bilingual Rosary for Life at the Monument for the Unborn at Calvary Cemetery at 2 pm on Sunday, January 19.

On Tuesday, January 21 at 6 pm there will be a Mass for the Unborn at the Cathedral of the Madeleine, celebrated by Bishop Solis. This will be in English and Spanish, and sign language interpreted.

The Utah March for Life, Saturday, January 25 at 1 pm at the State Capitol. This event is not sponsored by the Diocese of Salt Lake City but local Catholics are encouraged to participate.

Respect for the Dignity of Life Day is Saturday, February 1, 9 am - 1 pm at St Joseph the Worker Parish, 7405 S Redwood Rd, West Jordan. Jean Hill, director of the diocesan Office of Justice and Peace will speak on advocating for life issues at the legislature.

Please join us in prayer for the unborn, not only now, but throughout the year.

**United with those sanctified in Christ**

"To those who are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, together with all those everywhere who call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ..." 1 Cor. 1:2 This passage of the Holy Bible prepares us for next week that will begin the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church informs us that the mission of the Church is to embrace a special requirement of its catholicity. "The mission of the Church stimulates efforts towards Christian unity. Indeed, "divisions among Christians prevent the Church from realizing in practice the fullness of catholicity proper to her in those of her children who, although joined to her by Baptism, are still separated from full communion with her. Furthermore, the Church herself finds it more difficult to express in actual life her full catholicity in all its aspects." (C.C.C. # 855)

Here in our Parish, we have that diversity. We have many nationalities and when we are united in our Sunday celebration, we are one body in Jesus Christ. In every celebrations, we discover our unity in the diversity. Today I pray for that unity among us.

Unity within the Church can only be achieved when the faithful are obedient to their pastors, their Bishops and the Magisterium of the Catholic Church. To be in unity with the Church means to accept and defend all the teachings of the Church without exception. It does not mean to take what one likes and rejecting what one dislikes. Rejection leads to division and disharmony, such being the fruit of Satan who seeks to destroy the One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church that was instituted by Christ on earth.
