AND THE WORD BECAME FLESH

Last October on the Feast of Saint Jerome, Pope Francis declared that the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time is to be devoted to the celebration, study and dissemination of the Word of God.

He did this by publishing an Apostolic Letter, called *Aperuit Illis: Instituting the Sunday of the Word of God*. You can read this on the web page of the Vatican, *Vatican.va*. It is inspiring and thoughtful.

Having just celebrated the Word made Flesh and dwelt among us in the birth of Christ, we might still reflect on what that means for us today and how we experience the Word made flesh.

Another good reflection thought is: Why did God become man? In his book, "The Sacraments: Discovering the Treasures of Divine Life", Father Matthew Kauth proposes the question, what is a word? He says it is something sensible that may be heard if spoken and seen if written. It carries something spiritual with it because it communicates an idea.

Saint Augustine once said: "I can hear a word, but even when the sound is no more, the content of that word is not gone, it is in me."

In Scripture, we read that God created the world by his Word. He speaks and it comes to be and it accomplishes his Will: "For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven and do not return there but water the earth, making it bring forth and sprout, giving seed to the sower and bread to the eater, so shall my word be that goes forth from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I intend, and prosper in the thing for which I sent it. (Isaiah 55:10-11)

May our focus on God's holy Word today and every day help us welcome the presence of Christ in our souls as through the grace of our baptism we continue his ministry of priest, prophet and servant of the kingdom.

"Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, as in all wisdom you teach and admonish one another, singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God." (Colossians 3:16)

My Dear Brothers and Sisters!

Proclaiming the Good News of the Kingdom

As we enter the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, we are reminded that when Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in the synagogues and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom, the people saw a great light.

Speaking to his followers, Jesus said, *"I am the light of the world. He who follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life; but whoever says, "I am in the light," while he hates a brother or sister, remains in darkness. Whoever loves a brother or sister lives in the Light, and in such a person there is no cause for stumbling."*

Today's second reading from Paul's first letter to the Corinthians reveals that walking in the light means being united in Christ. In this particular letter, St. Paul appealed to the Corinthians to agree among themselves, that there be no division among them. In the Catholic community of faith where Christ is present, there must be perfect harmony among believers because of their communion and unity with Christ.

My brothers and sisters in Christ, there is only one Saviour, Jesus Christ who died on the cross for each and everyone of us. Through faith in Christ and the Sacrament of Baptism, we were incorporated into the one Body of Christ, not into the movement of this or that. There is only one Body of Catholics, not two.

I pray for unity here at St Marguerite, our parish community.
