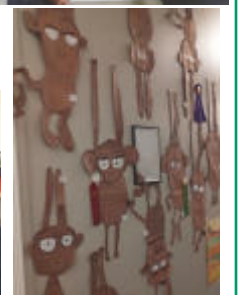
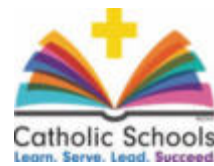

**My Dear Brothers and Sisters!**

**Let your light shine before others!**

"In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven."

Today's first reading from the book of Isaiah compliments the message of the Gospel reading. Beyond the fact that we are commanded to let our light shine before others, the Lord God tells us through the prophet Isaiah that our actions will determine our glory or our darkness.

A passage from the Gospel of Luke tells us that our Saviour Jesus, the "Light of the world," fulfilled the Lord's promise. Jesus said, "*The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour.*" "*Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.*"

In life, we have two choices. In the likeness of Christ, we can shine as a light in the world or we can be rejected by God for not realizing the ideal of the Gospel life. We cannot have both. We cannot serve two masters. We cannot win the world and Heaven. The outcome of our eternal blessings depends on the choice we make today, not tomorrow, because we might not be here tomorrow. No one knows when they will be called before the Lord.

My brothers and sisters in Christ, when we received the Sacrament of Confirmation, our Bishop sent us to preach and defend the Gospel. Our vocation obligates us to be lights in the world in the likeness of Christ, who is the source of all lights. This week, let us take the opportunity to evaluate the extent to which we are responding to our call, remembering the sacred words of Jesus, "Let your light shine before others." Mt. 5:16.

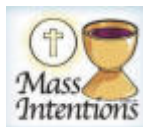
