SAINT MARGUERITE KNIGHTS TAKE PART IN UTAH MARCH FOR LIFE



THOUSANDS GATHER - - On Saturday, January 25, well over 2000 Pro-Life Utahns met in the Rotunda of the State Capital to listen to inspiring speakers before marching around the Capital in solidarity with Pro-Life Marches across America.

This January marked Utah's 5th Annual March For Life. Five years ago, 50 people showed up to march. This January, the numbers swelled to well over 2,000 and the positive energy was truly motivating. Bishop Oscar Solis led all in a Rosary for Life to begin the event and the March itself was orderly and reverent.

Knights of Columbus from around the state attended and helped to keep everyone and everything organized and moving along. The Knights have been pivotal in the Pro-Life Movement by providing 750 Ultrasound Machines to Pro-Life Pregnancy Centers in all 50 states, Canada, Jamaica, Guatemala and Peru at a cost of \$36M.

It is a statistical fact that when a pregnant woman can see her baby via an Ultrasound, the chances of her choosing abortion are greatly reduced. Utah has three Ultrasound machines provided by our state Knights. The jurisdictions having the most are Florida (59), California (48), Texas (48), Missouri (43) and Michigan (37). Each machine can cost up to \$60,000, depending on the model.

Several parishes in Utah provided buses for their members to attend and that is something for our parish to think about and discuss ahead of next year's March.

My Dear Brothers and Sisters!

Help us to dwell in Your Presence.

Greetings to you my friends on this Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time. One more Sunday and we will be in the Lenten Season, the wonderful time to intensify our spiritual life in order to be closer to God and to our brothers and sisters. From now on I invite you to take advantage of these forty days of Lent, starting on Ash Wednesday the 26 of this month.

Today's readings speak of spiritual maturity that begins when the individual is spiritually enlightened by God's grace and the power of the Holy Spirit. Spiritual maturity has to do with learning the spiritual virtues that will benefit the holiness of the soul.

When a preschool child touches something hot, he learns that it burns. If he climbs on a chair or goes up the stairs, he learns that he can fall down. Most children fall and hit their heads. In child development, the child progressively learns by natural instinct to use logic to ensure that his basic needs are met.

But what about when we become adults? Is our learning process completed? Many seem to think so! As adults, they consider themselves mature! But are we really mature in our whole being according to the teachings of the Bible?

Today's readings teach us that in our lives, in our work, in marriage, and even in our social lives, we should seek spiritual maturity. We should open our spiritual minds to the Holy Spirit who seeks everything, even the depths of God, so that we can know the will of God in all things. Knowing God's will, we should be moved to act upon it, performing the acts of good will that the Holy Spirit inspires in us.

We must stop seeing the difficulties and sufferings of life as punishments from God. Rather, we should ask ourselves: "What does God want me to learn from this discipline?" "What virtue can I derive from these difficulties or suffering?" Can I learn a patience that Adam and Eve could not learned? Can I learn to have compassion for others who have similar hardships? Can I learn not to judge?

When we have learned what God is trying to teach us, having been disciplined by the grace of a loving Heavenly Father and having been purified by the fire of the Holy Spirit, then my brothers and sisters, we will begin to shine as children of God in the likeness of God Himself.

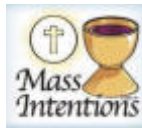

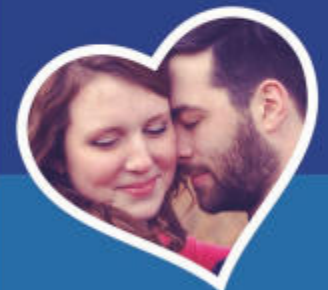
