Reflection brings a clearer perspective

Our parish will have the great joy of sharing a day of reflection together on March 7. We often gather for many social activities: Bingo, fish fries, spaghetti dinners, Sunday coffee and doughnuts, trips to Wendover, and the annual Fall Festival, as well as Mass. Nonetheless, during the season of Lent, we are blessed to have this opportunity to grow in the depth of our love of God and neighbor.

If you haven't made up your mind to attend our Parish Lenten Day of Reflection, consider a few reasons to join us.

A day of reflection can help us to grow spiritually as we learn about different aspects of our Catholic faith. We might even make a new friend who shares a similar love of Christ. By engaging in spiritual reflection, we can better understand who God desires us to become and help us be open to the conversion of heart God desires for us during Lent. And in case you don't understand exactly what reflection is, here is an explanation.

Spiritual reflection is the process of allowing the Holy Spirit to bring our attention to what's happening in our life in a mindful and faith-filled way. It can challenge our thoughts and help us avoid 'stinking thinking' (when we are stuck in negative thoughts).

Spiritual Reflection can help develop creative thinking skills, by helping put things into perspective, to work through decisions, to clarify thoughts, to solve problems, and to generate new ideas for living life more fully in Christ. It also helps us recognize change and even track our progress in loving and serving and being more like Jesus, who stepped away from the hustle and bustle of life frequently.

Spiritual Reflection has huge benefits in increasing self-awareness, which is a key component of emotional intelligence, and in developing a better understanding of God, ourselves, and others. Reflection encourages us to think about who we have been, who we are now, and who God desires us to be in the future. It is actually a basic step in developing the highest form of prayer, called contemplation, which can bring healing to our souls and help us to live with greater joy.

Most of us probably don't have the time to sit down every day and meditate, but a day of reflection gives us this opportunity. See you there on Saturday, March 7 at 8:30 am!

My Dear Brothers and Sisters!

Be perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect.

Quoting the last paragraph from today's Gospel Reading, Jesus says, *"For if you love those who love you, what reward do you have? Do not even the tax collectors do the same? And if you greet your brothers and sisters only, what more are you doing for others? Do not even the Gentiles do the same? Be perfect, then, as your heavenly Father is perfect."*

The precept for love of neighbor is from the Book of Leviticus where we read, "You shall not take revenge or hold a grudge against any of your people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself: "I am the Lord."

My brothers and sisters, no one needs to be instructed to hate his enemies; but, we do need to be reminded to love our enemies.

The meaning of the word "neighbor" as found in the Book of Leviticus is a reference to one's group or community: one's village or town, one's religion or nation, one's tribe or race. In many languages the same word is used to designate "stranger," "foreigner," or "enemy." The enemy is specified in the Matthew's Gospel as the persecutor, probably a reflection of the experience of the early Church.

Love within the group or community is simply a natural and universal human trait. But by implementing this kind of love, a forgiving love, the disciples were being perfected as our heavenly Father is perfect.

Let us remember this week: "Be perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect." Let us pray for one another that we may all have the strength to forgive our enemies so that we can be perfected by the power of the Holy Spirit in Jesus' most Holy Name to the glory of God the Father.

Diocesan Science Fair

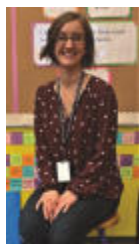
