**Charting our Mission**

Between 2014 and 2018, people and parishes from throughout the Diocese of Salt Lake City worked to produce a set of priority needs which were then translated into a Pastoral Plan. Much of their work took place under Archbishop Wester. The actual unveiling and promotion of the plan is being directed by Bishop Solis. He has encouraged each and every parish and diocesan staff agency to implement the plan in accordance with their specific needs over the next five years.

The five goals are: **faith formation** (which includes youth ministry, religious education, and formation for priests in homiletics), **vocations** (including missionary discipleship for all, nurturing vocations to the priesthood, religious life, diaconate and lay ecclesial ministry), **stewardship** (improving the sharing of time, talents, and treasure, strengthening Catholic schools), **Eucharist and Catholic Identity: Unity in Diversity** (catechesis on the liturgy, better planning for liturgies, welcoming priests from other countries), and **dignity of the human person** (strengthen ministry to the marginalized, to families and to care of the environment).



Our parish has begun working on faith formation through our days of reflection in preparation for Lent and through short teachings on the liturgy during the Sundays of Lent. Below are pictures from the first day of reflection which was in Spanish. It featured Father Rafael explaining the Pastoral Plan, Manuel Naranjo speaking on the meaning of the Lenten season, Lorena Needham addressing Unity in Diversity, and Olga and Martin Alvarado giving prayerful ideas for family life as the domestic church.

The next day of reflection will be March 7 and will feature Deacon Rick Huffman speaking on Lent, Lorena Needham's talk on Unity in Diversity, and Sister Catherine Kamphaus, CSC, Associate Superintendent of Catholic Schools speaking on Missionary Discipleship. Hope to see you there!

My Dear Brothers and Sisters!

Away with you, Satan!

How does today's celebration of the First Sunday of Lent relate to the creation of man versus Jesus spending forty days in the desert? My brothers and sisters in Christ, both events have to do with temptation! Allow me to explain...

Lent is a season of penance that has been set aside by the Catholic Church in memory of the forty days' fasting of Our Lord Jesus in the desert and as a mean of sanctification for its members. Beginning on Ash Wednesday, Lent includes forty fasting days. The Lenten Season is a time of fast for the purpose of gaining spiritual strength to resist all forms of temptations. It is a time to say firmly, "Be gone, Satan!"

"Lent is a time to ask yourself a series of questions. Where is life really leading me? Is the hope of eternal life my aspiration? Have I tried to grow in the life of the Spirit through prayer, reading the Word of God and meditating on it, receiving the Sacraments, self-denial? Have I been anxious to control my vices, my bad inclinations and passions, for example, envy, love of food and drink? Have I been proud and boastful, thinking I am better before God and despising others as less important than myself?"

By persevering in fasting, penances and prayers, Christian gain the strength they need to overcome their sinful tendencies.

Having entered the Lenten Season, this is a time to review our beliefs and expectations.

This week, we can reflect on these things and ask the Holy Spirit to guide us in the truth so that we can become precious pearls for the Lord. And when we are being tempted by the devil against the teachings of the Holy Catholic Church, let us raise our voices and say, "Away with you, Satan!"

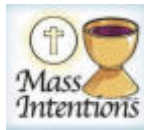
