#### The Grace of Spiritual Communion –

when we can't attend Mass



In response to the spread of the coronavirus, we are not able to attend Mass for the next few weeks. Yet, the Church teaches us we are to keep the Sabbath holy by attending Mass on Sunday and living our lives morally and compassionately through the source and summit of our faith – the Eucharist. So, while Bishop Solis has temporarily dispensed us from the obligation to attend Mass, we may still nurture our faith and keep the Sabbath holy by making a **Spiritual Communion** in addition to reflecting on the Scripture readings of the day.

Spiritual Communion may be a new concept and a mysterious reality for some of us; however, it has a long history with the saints. For centuries, Doctors of the Church, like St. Thomas Aquinas, St. Teresa of Avila, and St. Alphonsus Liguori, have proclaimed the benefits of the practice. St. Jean-Marie Vianney once said, "when we feel the love of God growing cold, let us instantly make a Spiritual Communion. When we cannot go to the church, let us turn toward the tabernacle; no wall can shut us out from the good God."

Essentially, Spiritual Communion gives us an extraordinary opportunity to satisfy our desire to be in union with Christ in the Holy Eucharist. More, it enhances our union with the entire Body of Christ – with all our fellow Christians. In fact, in 1983, the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith declared that all the effects of Holy Communion can be received through Spiritual Communion, when we are prevented from attending Eucharistic liturgies such as is the case today.

But how do we make a Spiritual Communion? Simply **pray sincerely**. St. Alphonsus Liguori wrote this prayer for a Spiritual Communion:

*My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the most Blessed Sacrament. I love You above all things and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.*

God always finds a way to provide us with His grace, especially in these troubling times. So let us pray to our Lord Jesus Christ to guide us through these trying times, to strengthen us spiritually, to protect us, and swiftly cure all those afflicted by the coronavirus.
