How mysterious are the ways of the Lord.

From today's readings, we perceive the depth of God's riches, wisdom and knowledge. We realize that the judgments of God that were unsearchable and mysterious at the time they occurred became known as they unfolded.

Through Isaiah, God told Shebna that he would be removed from office. In his place, God's servant, Eliakim, the son of Hilkiah, would take his place. All authority would be placed under him and he would be the father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem and to the house of Judah.

In the message to Shebna, God spoke of the key to the house of David. The words spoken by God, of a prophetic nature, are very similar to those we hear Jesus speaking to Peter in the today's Gospel reading. What Eliakim open, no one will close; what he closes, no one will open. The Lord will fasten him like a peg in a secure place, and he will become a throne of honor to his ancestral house. In this message, the key worn on the shoulder, represents the authority of its keeper to grant or deny admittance to the royal presence.

As we review today's Gospel, we once again see the mysteries of God in action. Many of the people did not know who Jesus was. Some thought that He was John the Baptist, Elijah, Jeremiah or even a prophet. To ensure the fulfillment of the prophecies found in the Scriptures, the Heavenly Father hid the identity of Jesus as the Messiah from the eyes of many of the people until Jesus rose gloriously.

After the Resurrection, the Divine Plan unraveled so that all who had a sincere heart could see that God had fulfilled His numerous promises of sending the Messiah to save His beloved people.

Who would have believed in the days of Jesus that Peter, a simple fisherman, would become the leader of the greatest Church in the world, the Holy Catholic Church? Who would have believed that Jesus would choose Peter, knowing in advance that Peter would deny knowing Him on three different occasions?

My brothers and sisters, sometimes in life, we do not understand why things happen the way they do. Every event, though mysterious at the time of its occurrence, serves a spiritual purpose for our individual spiritual growth and for the benefit of the Church as a whole.

Today, we may not understand why certain things are happening in our lives. Events can seem mysterious. But if we look at 5 or 10 events in our past, we can perceive what seems to be a mystery at the time. Now we may be able to see how we have gained spiritually from our life experiences. Although the Heavenly Father was mysterious in His ways at that time, His Divine Will is now made known to us.

This week, let us take the time to reflect on our past. Let us take the time to reflect on the mysterious ways of the Lord that have led us to where we are today. Let us take the time to perceive what our Heavenly Father has done for us so we may grow in the fruit of the Holy Spirit. And when our eyes are opened to the mysteries of the Lord, let us take a moment to thank Him for all that He has done for us, glorifying Him in His Most Holy Name.
