

Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross

September 14



“The Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross, celebrated every year on September 14, recalls three events: 1) The Finding of the True Cross by Saint Helena, the mother of the emperor Constantine; 2) The Dedication of churches built by Constantine on the site of the Holy Sepulcher and Mount Calvary; and 3) The restoration of the True Cross to Jerusalem in AD 629 by the Byzantine emperor Heraclius” (Wikipedia)

As Catholics, we celebrate the Exaltation of the Cross every September 14, but most importantly we “Lift High the Cross” at every Mass as we honor the Lord’s death and resurrection. We can’t talk about Christ, we can’t talk about the Gospel, we can’t talk about Heaven and NOT talk about the Cross. The Cross is an integral part of the story: Jesus himself taught that each one of us must pick up our crosses and follow him, and so as Christians, we keep the Cross in front of us always.

I don’t remember which saint said it, but I remember the quote: “Because there is power in the Cross, don’t pray that God takes away your crosses; pray that God gives you the strength to carry your crosses!”

“For us as Catholics, we believe in the power of the Cross, but it can’t be just a cross; it has to be a crucifix. We keep the body of Jesus, (the corpus) on the Cross so that we never forget what Jesus did on the Cross two-thousand years ago. The Cross is not a piece of art. The Cross is not just a symbol. The Cross is not just piece of jewelry that we wear around our necks. The Crucifix keeps the Cross from being too nice, too easy, and too common place. Crucifixes are meant to inspire us and raise our minds to God. In the Spanish tradition, Crucifixes are more graphic. In Spain, the Crucifixes are meant to make you feel the pain that Jesus went through on the Cross, and they look like it too! There’s lots of blood and torn flesh and gore. You definitely get the idea that you’re not looking at a beautiful piece of art, but a sign and a symbol of Christ’s death there on the Cross”


