Dear Parishioners of Saint Marguerite,

Thank you for the Mass intentions you request through our parish office. Thanks to God and to you, we have many requests. We are grateful for your generosity.

It is a beautiful Catholic tradition to ask a priest to offer a Mass for our beloved deceased family members. It is linked to our Christian duty to pray for the living and dead (CCC 2634-2637).

Interestingly, Canon Law (946) states that the faithful who give Mass offerings for special intentions are contributing to the good of the Church in its concern for the support of its ministers. Yet, to avoid the appearance that a Mass is being bought or sold, bishops designate the amount for a request and the parish is required to keep careful records of both requests and offerings. In this diocese the suggested amount for a Mass offering is \$10.

The best way to request your Mass intentions is through the office. If a specific date is important, ask well in advance. Weekend Mass intentions fill up quickly during the year. Weekday Masses are often more readily available for intentions.

For pastoral reasons, we are sometimes bound to pray for more than one intention in a Mass. When that happens, you will be called from our office to obtain your consent. Priests are allowed to include two or more intentions after all donors have been explicitly informed and freely consented to combining offerings, the time and place of the multiple intention Mass has been made public; and the practice occurs infrequently. In addition, each pastor, administrator (Canon 534 §1), and bishop (Canon 388 §1) must offer a Mass for the people of the parish every Sunday and holy day of obligation.

Pope Francis frequently reminds us that Masses are not for sale, yet, as faithful parishioners, we are asked to offer what we can each week for the support of the priest and our parish. Our offerings in all forms, conform us more and more to Christ and unite our offerings to Christ's offering.

Thank you so much again, and may God continue to bless our lovely parish of Saint Marguerite.

Shine as stars forever and ever!

Brothers and sisters, this weekend's reading of the Holy Scriptures, speaks of God's justice and mercy. We were told that we must seek righteousness in order to receive God's mercy. We were told that man's justice includes living and dying for Christ. And, we were told how the righteousness of God may not appear to be just at times.

In truth, the righteousness of the Lord is not the righteousness of man. The Lord God gives to those who please Him in the amount that He chooses. Is it not allowed to do what he wants with what belongs to Him?

The Lord God is just and fair in all His dealings with His children. No one will ever go unrewarded for the works that are credited to him or her. While everyone becomes a new creation of the divine seed during the Sacrament of Baptism, not everyone receives the bonuses that come from perseverance in faith. While all receive their salvation, those who gave their blood for Christ do not receive the same eternal reward as those who did not give their blood. Those who shone in spiritual works by the grace of God do not receive the same eternal reward as those who only go to church once a year at Easter... if they will receive a reward at all.

Our reward is according to our spiritual works by the grace of God. If we have a heart willing to serve the Lord, He will find spiritual work for us to do for the glory of His Kingdom. Seek justice and receive the mercy of God.

Consider what has just been said, there is a lesson to learn from this. If we want to shine like stars forever and ever, we must not ask what the Church can do for us, but rather, what can we do for the Church. Jesus did not put His angels on earth to evangelize. He put us here, that is, you and me, as lights in the world so that his glory might be manifested through us.

This week, let us reflect upon our divine call to evangelize. Let us ask ourselves, "What am I doing for the Church?" "How can I help bring others to the Church in Jesus' name?" "How can I help the Church to flourish by the power of the Holy Spirit so that our Heavenly Father will be pleased with my actions?"
