THE FEAST OF THE ARCHANGELS

The three Archangel Saints: Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael, are invoked in Mass on September 29. Understanding the meaning of their names gives us great insight as to how these powerful angels help us today.

Saint Michael is described in the Books of Daniel and Revelation as fighting fallen angels. His name in Hebrew is a question: *Who is like unto God?* Tradition teaches that in the war in heaven among the angels, Lucifer said, *I shall rise to the throne of God.* But then Michael rises up and says, *Who is like unto God?*

Saint Gabriel also appears in the Book of Daniel and in Luke's Gospel. His name means *The Strength of God* or *God is my strength*. He is the angel announcing to both Zachariah and Our Blessed Mother the miraculous news of their children. Tradition teaches Saint Gabriel will blow the trumpet at the end of time to announce the end of the ages and the glorious second coming of Our Blessed Lord.

Saint Raphael manifests in the book of Tobit. His name means *The Healing of God* or *God has healed*. Raphael first appears disguised in human form as the traveling companion of Tobit's son, Tobias. He is often pictured or described as holding a flask or sounding a trumpet.

Knowing the names of these powerful Archangels lets us ask them to intercede for us during these difficult times. Let us ask Saint Michael to temper our pride and humble ourselves before our loving God and to defend us against the wiles of the devil. Saint Gabriel to announce to us that Our Lord Jesus Christ has come and will come again in glory to remove fear and sorrow from our lives. Lastly, Saint Raphael to bring healing upon those suffering from Covid 19 and its effects as well as healing and peace to our troubled world.
