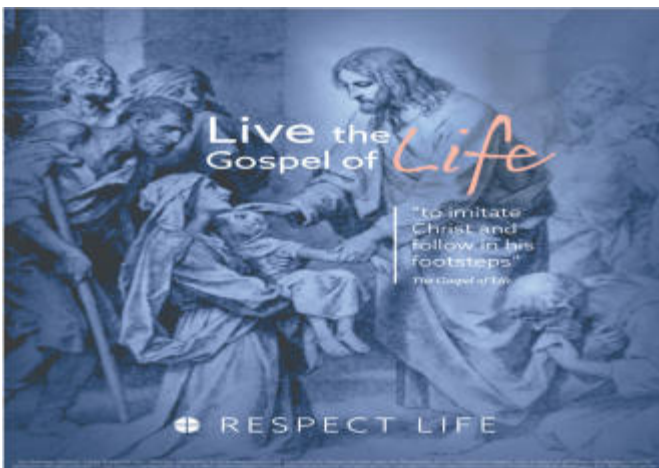

**Extraordinary Missionary Month –  
 Who is sent out on Mission?**

Before the baptismal water dries on our forehead and the oil on our chest and head has soaked into our souls, we become missionary disciples. To renew our awareness of this extraordinary call on our lives, Pope Francis has designated October as **Extraordinary Missionary Month**. His goals are to remind us of our spiritual transformation into God's daughters and sons and to reinvigorate our commitment to this way of life.

Journeying forth from the baptismal font, the Church gives us four paths of development to follow throughout our missionary lives. First, we are to nurture our personal relationship with Christ in the Church: in the Eucharist, in Scripture, and in prayer. Each Mass is a heavenly encounter filled with much-needed graces. Our full, conscious, and active participation in Mass not only gives us a ministry to fulfill but also lifts up the rest of God's family by our witness of faith. Through the Mass, the Word of God shapes our conscience, our behavior, our thinking, our relationships, our parish, our community, and our world. Discernment of God's Will comes through personal prayer, as well as, the Mass. In the quiet of the morning, the surrender of each night, in private and in faith community, prayer connects us with Christ. It is He who sends us out on mission at the end of each Mass.

Wherever we go, our lives are testimony to our faith. The manner in which we care for the earth, the poor, the sick, the disenfranchised, our parish, our family, our neighbor, and our society expresses our relationship with the Lord. Our commitment to giving of ourselves, along with our treasure and talent is a light for others to follow.

Missionary disciples are called to lifelong learning and teaching. Our favorite books are the Bible and the Catechism of the Catholic Church. With the wisdom gained therein, we reignite the working of the Holy Spirit in our lives and in the lives of those we teach and encounter.

The fourth path of missionary discipleship is found in the excellent way we love. Barriers are broken down with love and forgiveness. Spiritual growth is reinvigorated through love. God's love is delivered to people who are hungry to be affirmed or find themselves in difficult life circumstances.

Pope Francis puts it together for us: "In this year marked by the suffering and challenges created by the Covid-19 pandemic, the missionary journey continues the calling of the prophet Isaiah: "Here am I, send me" (6:8). This is the ever-new response to the Lord's question: "Whom shall I send?" (ibid.)."

The fruitful shall inherit the Kingdom of God.

Greetings to all of you, my dear parishioners. Today, as we listen to the readings, we hear similarities between the first reading from the book of Isaiah and the Gospel of Matthew. Both spoke of the same subject in different ways. The Book of Isaiah refers to “The Song of the Unfruitful Vineyard” while the Gospel of Matthew refers to “The Parable of the Wicked Tenants”.

The vineyard represents Israel, God’s chosen people, who had been freed from captivity, brought to the Promised Land and who received endless blessings from the Lord. The landowner is the Lord God who called the chosen people. They are His people.

We are told that at harvest time, the landowner sent his slaves to the tenants to gather his produce. Likewise, we are told that when God expected justice from His people in return for His blessings, he sent the prophets. The tenants, the chief priests and Pharisees, seized the prophets, beat one, killed another and stoned another. All the prophets who were sent by God, one by one, received the same treatment.

The owner of the land is Jesus himself. He has established his Holy Catholic Church on earth, and has left this world to sit at the right hand of the Father. While still in charge of his Church, he left tenants to produce the fruit of the Holy Spirit. The tenants are those who have been admitted into the Body of Christ, having been baptized, having received the promised gift of the new creation, the new heart and human spirit of the divine seed. They are the holy priesthood, the children of God who will inherit the eternal Kingdom.

This week, let us all take a few moments to review our status before God, asking ourselves if we will inherit the Kingdom of God. If we fail to manifest God’s holy ways, let us renew our commitment to persevere in our living faith in Christ through sincere repentance and the reception of the Sacraments. May the grace of God be with each and everyone of you as you evaluate your spiritual state in the eyes of God. Amen.
