OUR LITURGICAL YEAR BEGINS

This Sunday marks the First Sunday of Advent and is the time for our spiritual preparation leading up to the Birth of Christ. Advent begins on the Sunday closest to the Feast of Saint Andrew the Apostle, which is on Monday, November 30 and spans four Sundays and four weeks of preparation for the birth of our Lord.

The celebration of Advent has evolved in the spiritual life of the Church and the historical origins of it are not easily determined. In its earliest forms, beginning in France, it was a preparation for baptism, which is now done during Lent with prayer and fasting. But in 380 AD, the local Council of Zaragosa, Spain established a three week fast and then, two hundred years later the Council of Macon, France designated that from November 11 (The Feast of Saint Martin of Tours) until Christmas, fasting would be required on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

Eventually, similar practices spread to England. In Rome, the Advent preparation didn't appear until the Sixth Century AD and was viewed more as a preparation for the Birth of Christ than a time for penance.

Gradually, the Church more formalized the celebration of Advent. Pope Saint Gelasius I (d.496) was the first to provide Advent Liturgies. Later, Pope Gregory I (d.604) enhanced these Liturgies composing prayers, antiphons, readings and responses. Finally, in about the ninth century, the Church designated the First Sunday of Advent as the beginning of the Church year.

Despite the here-and-there history behind Advent, its importance cannot be understated. It remains to focus on the coming of our Lord. Our Catechism stresses the two-fold meaning and spiritual importance of the Birth of Jesus and the faithful renew our ardent desire for His Second Coming. So we reflect back on His Miraculous Virgin Birth, pondering the great mystery of His Incarnation when our Lord humbled Himself by taking on our frail humanity as we recall in the Creed that our Lord will come again to judge the living and the dead and that we must be ready to meet Him.

The 25th Ordination Anniversary of Father Rafael - December 14, 2020


