

Prepare the way of the Lord!

Greetings my brothers and sisters. Today's readings tell us to prepare the way for the coming of the Lord Jesus. As Christmas approaches, when we celebrate God's incarnation on earth, we are reminded how the people of the Old Testament looked forward to the arrival of infant Jesus as the promised Messiah. Throughout the New Testament, we are reminded of the Lord's patience in His second and final coming that will serve the purpose of our salvation, the Lord not wanting anyone to perish.

Through Isaiah, God told the people to prepare the way for his coming. They were not told when He would come, whether it would be in a year, ten years or a hundred years. As biblical history reveals to us, many generations passed before the Lord Jesus was born, in fact, about seven hundred years.



Through the Sacrament of Baptism, we have all become participants of the spiritual and invisible Kingdom of God.

By God's grace and the power of the Holy Spirit in Jesus' Holy Name, we allow all these things to happen to us so we may be spiritually transformed to prepare the way of the Lord.

United in prayer for the lost souls, we rejoice that the Lord is delaying His final return as the assurance of the salvation of many who would otherwise not be saved. The Immaculate Conception

“QUE SOY L” IMMACULADA COUNCEPEIUO”



was the lady’s response to Bernadette Soubirous’s inquiry: “What is your name?”

“I am the Immaculate Conception,” the beautiful lady dressed in a white gown, blue sash and white veil, with golden roses on her feet, replied when asked who she was. That was on March 25, 1858, in a grotto near Lourdes, France,

Just four years prior to that, in 1854, the Church had declared “the Immaculate Conception” a dogma of the Catholic

Church whereby every Catholic **must** believe that Mary, the Mother of Jesus Christ, the Son of God, was herself **conceived from original sin**.

The catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us that, to become the Mother of the Savior of humankind, Mary was **“enriched”** by God with gifts appropriate to such a role.” In order for Mary to be able to give her free assent to the announcement of her “Vocation”, “it was necessary that she be wholly **borne** by God’s grace.” The angel Gabriel attests to this at the moment of the Annunciation when he salutes her as “Full of Grace.”



Through the centuries the church has become ever more aware that Mary, “full of grace” through God, was redeemed from the moment of her conception in her mother’s womb. That is what the dogma of the Immaculate Conception confesses, just as Pope Pius IX proclaimed in 1854.

The dogma of the Immaculate Conception affirms our belief, as Catholics, in “the facts” preserved for us in sacred scripture, particularly the Holy Bible.

To fully appreciate the dogma’s importance to our faith we have to appreciate the biblical story of creation, the fall of man, and the promise of a Savior. We have to believe as well in what the Church teaches us about **“Original Sin”** and **“the effects of original sin”**... and **that is that ... “Sacred Scripture and Church Dogma ‘IS’ the Truth,” ... “it is not a fairy tail.”**

God did create everything, including man; man did disobey God and because of “that sin” everything “that is not good” came into the world. God promised a Savior and created Mary, the Immaculate Conception, and, Mary gave birth to *that Savior*, Jesus.

Jesus came into this world to save us from the effects of original sin. He accomplished this by suffering and dying on the cross. And, he established his Church as the means by which all generations can be saved from the effects of Original Sin. Amen!




Every Day Stewardship
