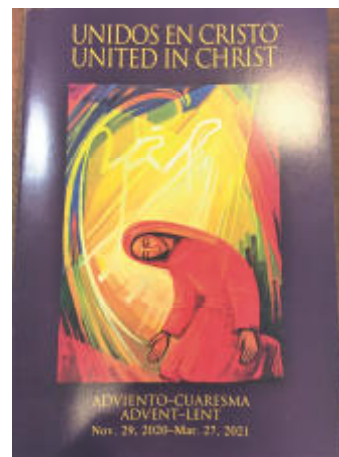

The best way to request your Mass intentions is through the office. If a specific date is important, ask well in advance. Weekend Mass intentions fill up quickly during the year. Weekday Masses are often more readily available for intentions.

For pastoral reasons priests, are sometimes bound to pray for more than one intention in a Mass. When that happens, you will be called by our office to obtain your consent when possible. Priests are allowed to include two or more intentions after all donors have been explicitly informed and freely consented to combining offerings.

Sometimes, but not often, a priest will be called away on a day when a Mass has been scheduled. If this happens the office will call you to reschedule the Mass as closest to the date that the original Mass was requested.
