FROM OUR DEACON



The Christmas Season is a time to remember revelations - revelations of God's love for us. A couple weeks ago we celebrated the great mystery of the Nativity of Our Lord: The Second Person of the Blessed Trinity took flesh from the Blessed Virgin Mary and was born as true God and true man as an infant in Bethlehem. On Christmas night he was revealed to shepherds, who were among the most poor and humble of Jesus' own race and nation. The message of the angels to the shepherds announced Jesus as their king and their savior of the people of Israel.

Last Sunday was the Feast of the Epiphany.

Today we see Jesus baptized by John in the River Jordan. This event is the formal beginning of Jesus' public mission and ministry. In the Baptism of the Lord, we find yet another revelation: Jesus himself sees the heavens opened, and he sees the Holy Spirit come upon him in the form of a dove. That's the same Spirit of God who, in the book of Genesis, hovered over the waters at the dawn of Creation. This is the beginning of the New Creation. Jesus hears a voice which he recognizes as that of his Eternal Father, for Jesus is his beloved son.

Our faith and our religion depend on these revelations. In each of them God tells us something about who he is, and who we are. God reveals himself as the one who loves us, a God who is concerned for us and involved in our world. He lets us know that he takes an active role in the life of each one of us. He reveals Jesus as the Lamb, who frees us from eternal death by taking our sins upon himself. This is the meaning of Jesus' action today, as revealed in the conversation between him and John the Baptist. Don't forget to pray and seek forgiveness from He who Loves us!!!

Since most of us were baptized as infants, we do not remember the event. Yet, no matter what age you were baptized, it still has the same effects: cleansing of sin, imparting of grace, giving of the Holy Spirit, adoption as a child of God, and incorporation into the Church. Take time today to thank God for the gift of baptism and reflect on the importance of your baptism.

Baptism begins our covenant relationship with God. Like all covenantal relationships (e.g. marriage), this relationship takes work. Make an extra effort this week to invest time and energy into your relationship with God and ask for His grace to help you grow closer to Him

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

When God Whispers

“You don’t need to shout. My hearing works just fine.”

Are you a parent that has used that one on your kids? I’m not sure at what age they realize that the volume of their voice doesn’t correlate to the likelihood of receiving a favorable reply — it might be sometime in the teenage years, when the talking slows down altogether.


But I’ve got to admit, it would be nice if God always gave us a loud and dramatic sign when He wanted something — the booming voice and the torn-open heavens (“This is my beloved Son!”) really get the message across. Sometimes I find myself envious of the Apostles, who were able to witness such things in person.

The fact of the matter is, in the year 2021, God is more likely to speak in a whisper than in a shout. The prophet Isaiah forewarns that Christ himself will not be a noisemaker — for all his preaching, he will not cry out or shout to bring forth justice to the nations. His way is altogether different than that.

We are not the Apostles, and we do not have the privilege of seeing the Holy Spirit descend on Christ like a dove. But here’s the good news: God doesn’t need to shout. Our spiritual hearing works just fine. We just have to be listening.

Let’s wake up each morning ready to hear God’s whispers throughout the day. Let’s make a conscious effort to invite those whispers into our hearts, where they can become a catalyst for grace in this world.


