**Follow Me and I will make you fishers of men!**

My dear brothers and sisters in the Lord Jesus,  
 During today's first reading from the Book of Jonah, we hear how Jonah responded to God's calling. He was called by God to go to Nineveh, where he was to proclaim the message of the Lord. In obedience, Jonah went to Nineveh and proclaimed the Word of God, advising sinful people that unless they repented of their sins, in forty days, their city would be overthrown.

The people turned away from their evil ways. Consequently, God changed his mind about the calamity he was about to send to Nineveh. Through Jonah, the faithful servant of the Lord, the people were once again united in the righteous ways of the Lord God.

Like Jonah, we all have a calling. Some are called to the Sacrament of Holy Orders or religious life. Some are called to the Sacrament of Marriage. Some are called to live a life of celibacy. Teenagers and children also have a calling. While the vocation of each may vary according to his or her status in life, the needs of the Church are many. Jesus calls some to preach, to be lectors, Eucharistic ministers, ushers, altar servers, choir members, members of parish committees, members of the Catholic Women's League or Knights of Columbus, ministers to the home bound, the list goes on. There is a place for everyone in the Body of Christ.

Each member of the Body of Christ is a living stone belonging to a great Temple, the House of God. If we remove some of the stones from the structure, it will begin to fall. Likewise, if all the members of the Body of Christ and especially of the Parish, are not actively involved in the ministry of the Church, the Parish will suffer. The Church needs you!

Let us ask Jesus to strengthen us in our works so we may shine as true light in the world, showing patience where it is needed, love where there is hatred, kindness where it is the least expected.

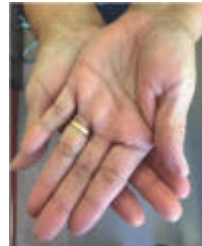


**TOOELE FOOD BANK CONTINUES TO NEED OUR HELP!**

**Instructions At Communion**

When approaching the Altar to receive Holy Communion, keep your mask on, stand behind the yellow line on the floor, extend your arms as far as possible, receive the Lord's body in your hands, then step to the side, adjust your mask and consume the host by picking it up with your right hand. If you do not wish to receive communion in the hand, simply cross your arms over your chest, receive a blessing and pray the Spiritual Communion Prayer.



Left hand on top make a throne. Right hand underneath.



Arms crossed over your chest to receive a blessing.

**Instrucciones para la Comunión**

Al acercarse al Altar para recibir la Sagrada Comunión, manténgase con la máscara puesta, párese detrás de la línea amarilla en el suelo, extienda los brazos lo más posible, reciba el cuerpo del Señor en su mano izquierda, luego párese a un lado, ajuste su máscara y consuma la hostia recogiéndola con su mano derecha. Si no desea recibir la comunión en la mano, simplemente cruce los brazos sobre el pecho, reciba una bendición y rece la Oración Comunión Espiritual.
