Dear Parishioners, today we continue reading the Gospel of Mark, learning more about Jesus' ministry. Jesus healed Simon's mother-in-law, and she immediately began to serve Jesus and his disciples. Jesus also healed many others who were brought to him, healing their illnesses and casting out demons. As we will see throughout Mark's Gospel, Jesus did not allow the demons to speak because they knew his identity and would have revealed it to those who were present.

Today's Gospel completes a picture of Jesus' ministry: preaching, healing the sick, casting out demons, and then moving on to continue this work elsewhere. Mark's Gospel tells us that Jesus did this throughout Galilee.

Jesus' compassion and healing of the sick is a sign of the Kingdom of God. The Church continues to extend the healing presence of Christ to others in her ministry. In the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, the Church prays for spiritual and physical healing, forgiveness of sins and comfort for those who are suffering from illness.

In today's Gospel we also notice the importance of **prayer** in Jesus' daily life. Jesus got up early in the morning, withdrew himself from the crowd and went to a deserted place to pray. When the disciples found him, he told them that it was time to move on. We believe that in his prayers Jesus found God's guidance and direction. We also bring our decision-making to God in prayer, asking for his guidance and direction in our lives.

Reflection: Like St. Paul in the second reading, the good steward can say, "I do all that I do for the sake of the Gospel in the hope of sharing in its blessings."



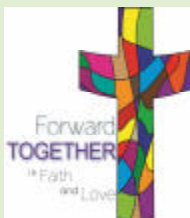

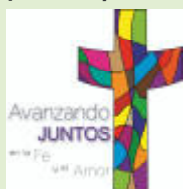

Vatican modifies distribution of ashes for Ash Wednesday. Vatican News

The Congregation for Divine Worship releases a note laying out the procedures to follow for the distribution of ashes at the start of Lent.

After blessing the ashes and sprinkling them with holy water in silence, the priest addresses those present, reciting once the formula found in the Roman Missal: "*Repent, and believe in the Gospel*" or "*Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return*".

At that point, the note continues, the priest "cleanses his hands, puts on a face mask, and distributes ashes to those who come to him or, if appropriate, he goes to those who are standing in their places." He then sprinkles the ashes on each person's head "without saying anything."

MIÉRCOLES DE CENIZA 2021: ¿CÓMO SE IMPONDRÁ LA CENIZA EN PANDEMIA?

1. El sacerdote pronunciará la oración de bendición de las cenizas.
2. Tras asperjar las cenizas, el sacerdote se dirigirá con el agua bendita a los fieles.
3. Dirá, a una sola voz y para todos los presentes: "Convértese y crea en el Evangelio", o "Polvo eres y en polvo te convertirás".
4. Después, el sacerdote deberá limpiarse las manos y colocarse correctamente el cubrebocas.
5. Enseguida, sin decir nada, impondrá la ceniza a quienes se acerquen respetando las medidas sanitarias.
6. O bien, se acercará a los fieles en sus lugares, tomará la ceniza y la deja caer sobre la cabeza de cada uno formando una cruz.

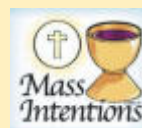
