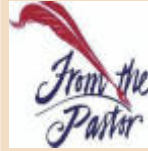

Perseverance, the work of faith



Twelve days into the season of Lenten, it is a good time to review how our 'living faith' and perseverance are leading us toward our eternal glory. Today's readings from the Holy Scriptures serve that specific purpose in our lives.

The first reading from the Book of Genesis tells us that God tested Abraham. In other words, God tested his living faith. God wanted to see how faithful Abraham would be in obedience and servitude. In this particular reading that speaks of Abraham and Isaac as father and son, we see many images of God the Father and His Son, Jesus Christ. When God called upon Abraham, Abraham responded, "Here I am." The two words, "I am," echo the identity of both God the Father and Jesus Christ. These two words, prophetic in nature, implied the arrival of Jesus into the world as the promised Messiah. As Genesis tells us, Abraham obeyed God.

Today, we can perceive what this promise of God meant. We know that Abraham was to become the spiritual father of mankind. [Roman. 4:17] He was the first of those to be saved by his living faith in God, first through the angel of God in the Old Testament and then through Jesus Christ in the New Testament.

Let us ask the Lord Jesus to strengthen and to keep our faith alive through the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist in the Mass. This is especially important to us during the season of Lent, when we are called to reflect upon our Christian life in preparation for the Resurrection of Jesus Christ to be celebrated on Easter Sunday.

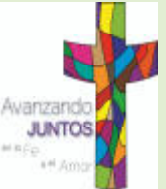
The 2021 Diocesan Development Drive
