"God spoke all these words."

How appropriate these words are for the season of Lenten. In the First Reading, we hear the words of God the Father. In the Second Reading, we hear the Words of the Holy Spirit speaking through St. Paul. And, in the Gospel of St. John, we hear the Words of Jesus.

From these readings, each Divine Presence of the Holy Trinity provides us with a message on how we should prepare ourselves during the season of Lent. And for those who are parents of children, the message includes the "how to" of preparing your little ones for the approach of Easter, the glorious Feast of the Resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ.

In today's Gospel, we hear of when Jesus went up to the Temple in Jerusalem as the Passover approached. There he found people selling animals and exchanging money in his Father's House. Making a whip, Jesus drove out the animals and overturned the tables of the money changers.

During the season of Lent, this Gospel passage bears another spiritual meaning. We are the temples of the indwelling Holy Spirit. As Jesus cleansed the Temple from the animals and money changers, we must cleanse our Temples from our habits, from our vices, from our sins, from all that is unjust and offensive to the Lord God. We are called by the grace of the Heavenly Father and the power of the Holy Spirit to sanctify our Temples in Christ.

As we continue on our journey toward Easter, let us reflect on the cleansing of our Temples. Let us reflect on what God has said to us today through the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Let us now make a firm commitment to cleanse our Temples (our body and our soul) for the glory of God.

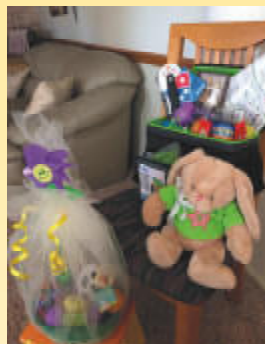

Reflection



Jesus' public ministry itself was patterned by his pilgrimage to Jerusalem for the great Jewish feasts. Greater by far is the temple, not made by human hands, of our Lord's Body, of which he says, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up."

The Creator is infinitely greater than his creatures. Far beyond the ability of mere creatures is the worship due the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of the Lamb of God. Only in the Son can we worship the Almighty in a fitting way. Now adopted by God in baptism we dare to call God "Father" and to approach the Holy of Holies. Do we show the proper respect to the Holy of Holies?

Each tabernacle housing the Body and Blood of the Lord is a true "Ark of the Covenant". It is the presence of the living God himself who makes each church and chapel a true temple, where we must bow down in awe before the all-holy God. Jesus went up to the Temple as the privileged place of encounter with God.

Because of Christ our churches today are indeed a "privileged place of encounter with God." Our reverence for the temples of today should far outweigh the reverence of the apostles for the Jewish temple. Peter and the Apostles have handed down to us through the true priesthood the living Christ in the Holy Eucharist.

Do we offer the reverential worship demanded of us by Christ's divinity as we stand in his presence before the tabernacle? Do we mistake his silent presence for permission to ignore him? Do we genuflect upon entering and prior to departing our churches?

Do we genuflect in procession to receive the living God? Do we struggle against the temptation to turn our churches into auditoriums, rehearsal halls, or theaters? Do we call attention to ourselves in needless conversation?

We love God with our whole heart, mind, soul and strength in our reverent love for Jesus Christ our Eucharistic Lord. "He who has seen me has seen the Father." We must express the "deepest respect" for God. We worship the true temple, the Lamb of God, in the Lord's Body and Blood.

Destroyed and risen again in three days, Christ himself present in the most Holy Sacrament of the Altar makes a mere church building the holiest place on earth.

Currently enrolling for the 2021-2022 school year.


