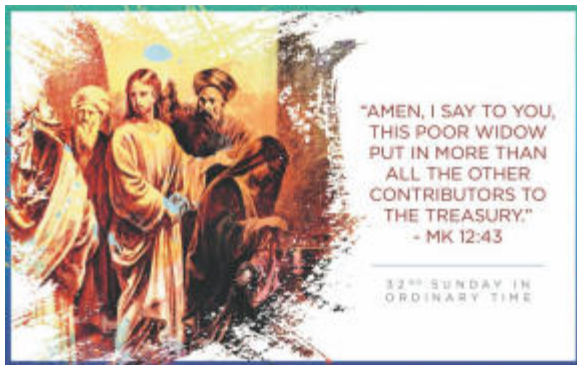

From the Pastor's Desk
Dear brothers and Sisters, I would like to take this opportunity to let you know that Pope Francis with the whole church has initiated the Synod, 2021 to 2023. So, two years from now, in October 2023, the worldwide Synod of Bishops will meet in council in the XVI Ordinary General Assembly. With input from the entire Church, the bishops will develop a plan for the Church to journey forward together and with fellow Christians.

Pope Francis invites the entire Church to reflect on a theme that is decisive for its life and mission: "It is precisely this path of synodality which God expects of the Church of the third millennium." This journey, which follows in the wake of the Church's "renewal" proposed by the Second Vatican Council, is both a gift and a task: by journeying together and reflecting together on the journey that has been made, the Church will be able to learn through Her experience which processes can help Her to live communion, to achieve participation, to open Herself to mission.

In the next weeks we may receive new guidelines from the Diocese and see how it will be for our participation as member of the mystical body of Jesus Christ.

Guided by the Holy Spirit, we make up the living stones through whom God builds up the Church that he desires for the third millennium. May the Blessed Virgin Mary, Queen of the Apostles and Mother of the Church, intercede for us as we journey together on the path that God sets before us.

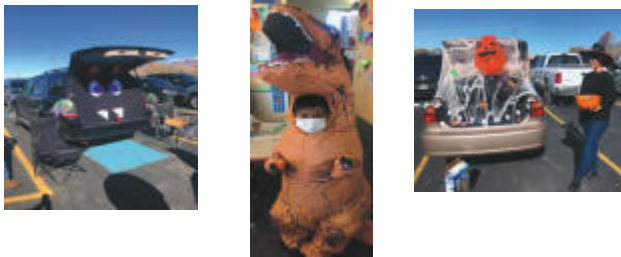
SMCS students take a stand against bullying and promise to remain drug free during Red Ribbon Week. Pictured are winners of our coloring contest.

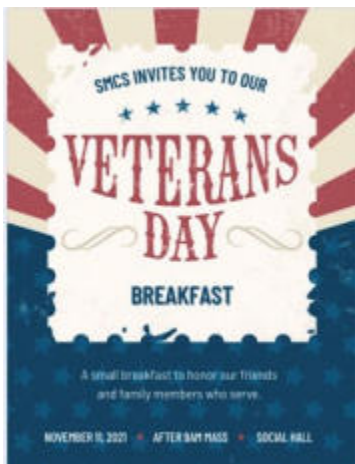
