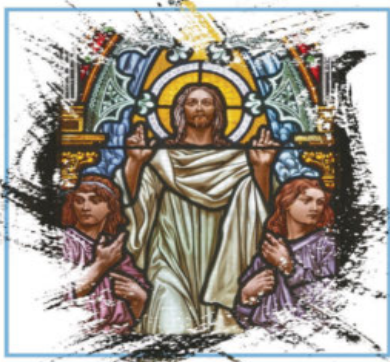

So, we get together to remember the infinite goodness and love of the Lord Jesus who has revealed the Heavenly Father to us.

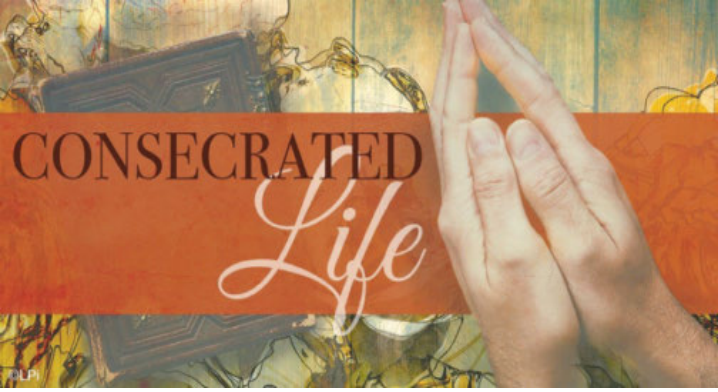

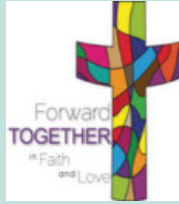


The 2021 Diocesan Development Drive

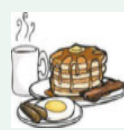

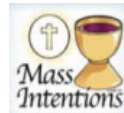
Grupo de Oración en Español
