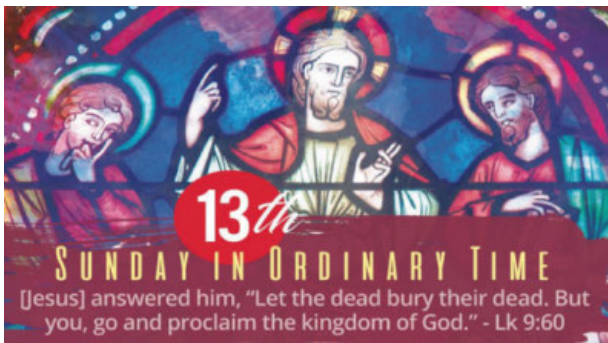

First Reading

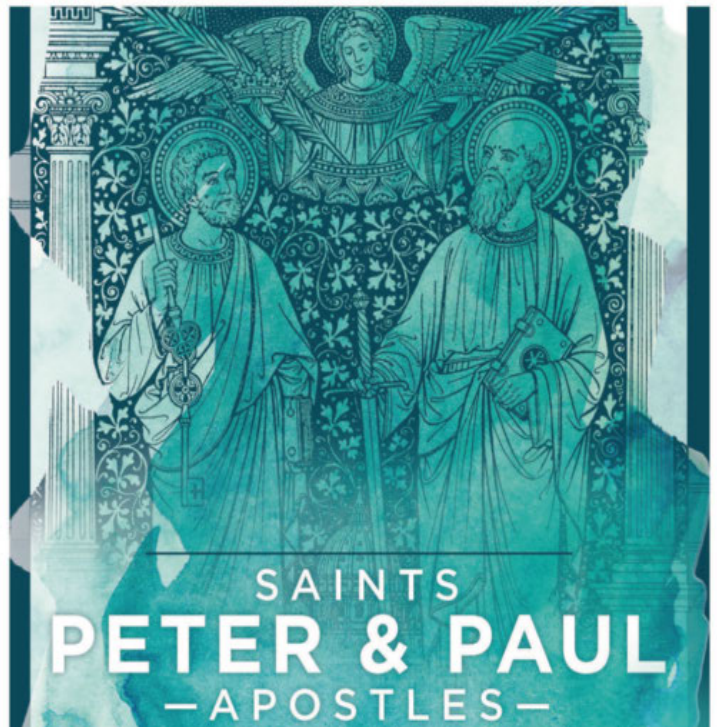

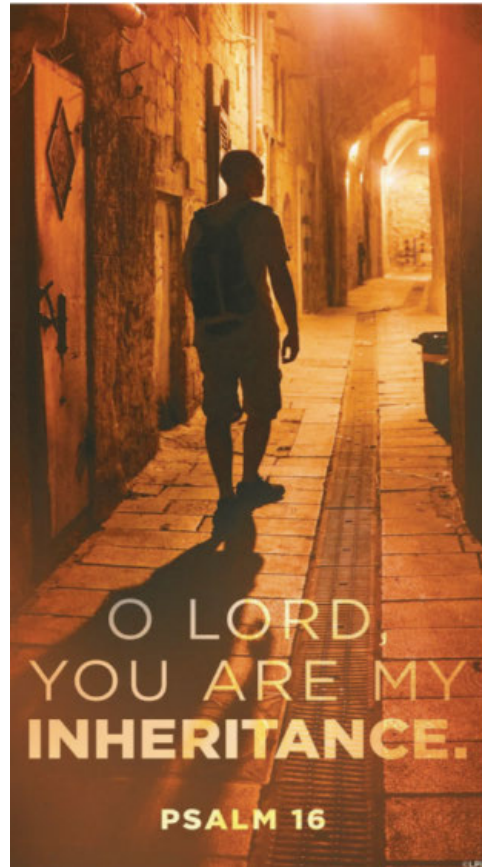
Volunteers needed for upcoming school year:

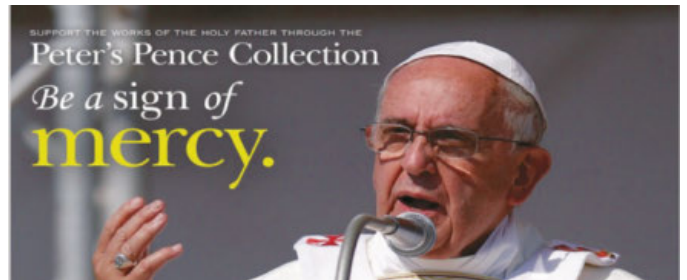
