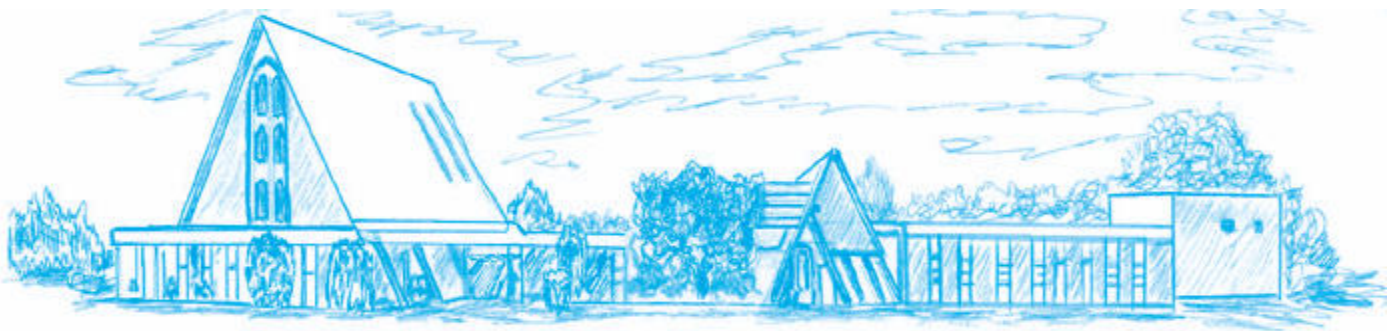
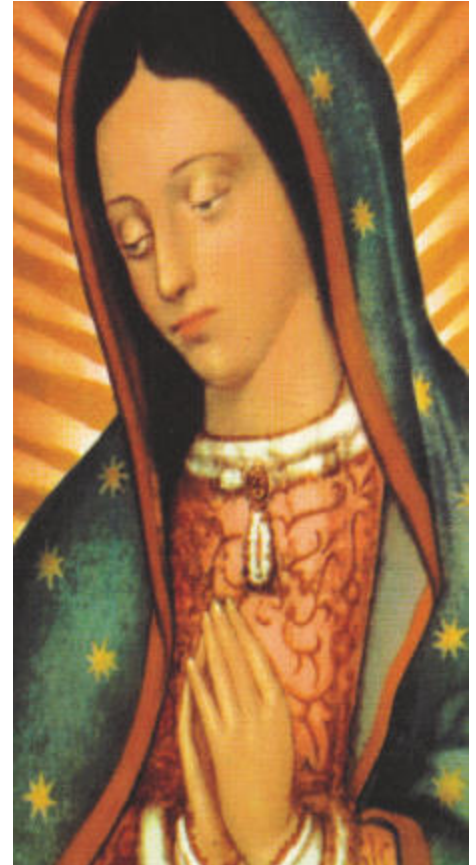

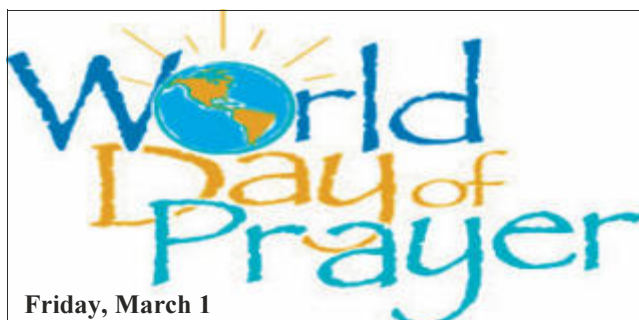

The family originally moved to Alamosa, CO, before moving to Rochester, NY, back to Poland for a year, and finally settling in the Albuquerque/Rio Rancho area in 1997. That is where Fr. Michael was raised, receiving his Sacraments at St. Thomas Aquinas Parish. It was in high school that Fr. Michael allowed his Catholic faith to become more than just a consequence of being Polish and something crucially important in his life. He graduated from Cibola High School in 2008 and (having wrestled with God about it for a good while!) entered seminary at the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, OH in the Fall of that same year. After four years there, he was sent to the North America College in Rome, Italy, where he completed his graduate studies in Theology and Sacred Scripture. He was ordained in May 2016, in Santa Fe and now serves as Associate Pastor at Our Lady of Sorrows in Bernalillo and Associate Vocations Director for the Archdiocese.
