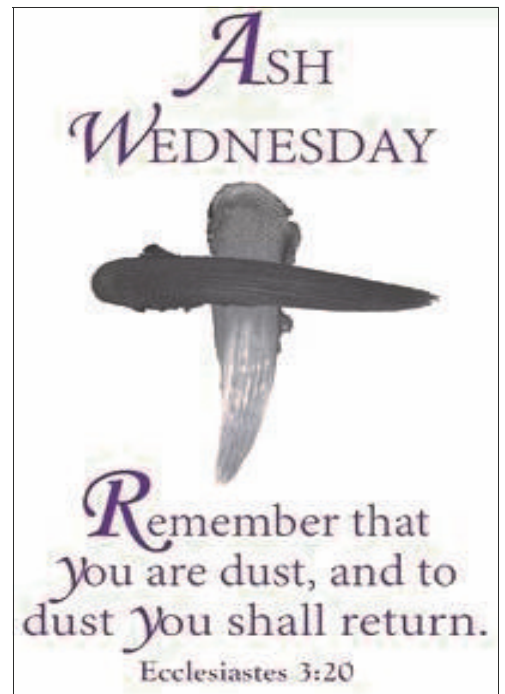
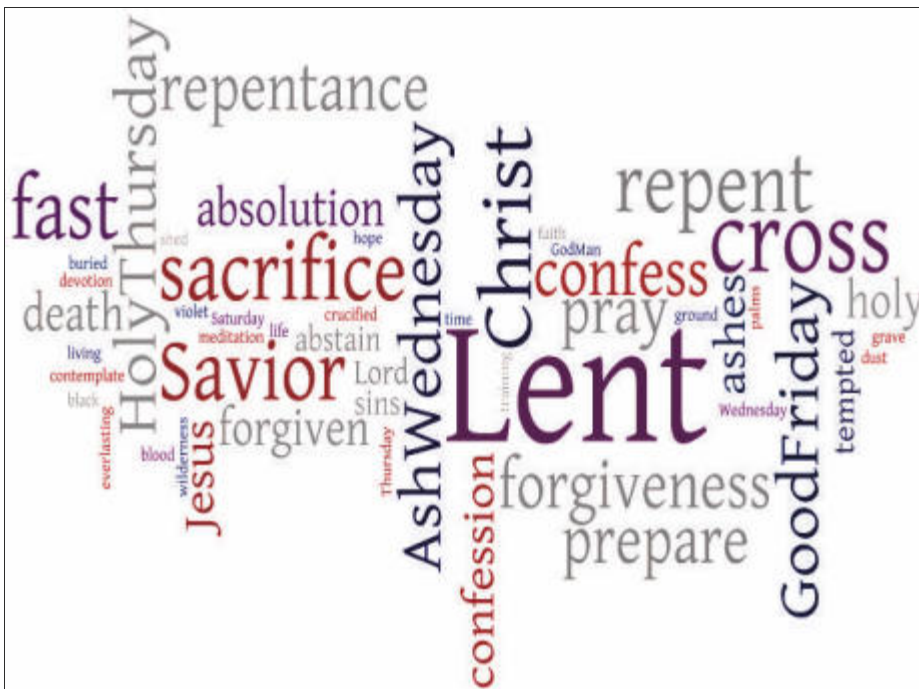

**LENT**

Lent is a season of prayer, fasting and almsgiving in preparation for the renewal of baptismal promises at Easter. Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 6, when all are called to turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel. Catholics are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. That means Catholics 18-59 years old are required to keep a limited fast—eat a single, normal meal and have lesser meals, as long as these do not add up to a second meal. Children are not required to fast. Those with medical conditions requiring greater or more regular food intake may be dispensed from fasting. Catholics are required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent. This applies to Catholics who are 14 years or older. Persons with dietary needs may be dispensed from this requirement.
