**LENT**

**Sacrament of Reconciliation:** Confessions will be heard all Fridays of  
 Lent, at 7:00 p.m. in Pojoaque, on Saturdays at 2:00 p.m. and on Good  
 Friday—after the 1:00 p.m. Living Way of the Cross.

All Catholics are encouraged to go to Confession during Lent.

**Need a refresher on how to go to Confession?**

Pray to the Holy Spirit for a Good Confession. Prepare yourself by  
 making an examination of conscience and making a mental list or  
 writing down what you will tell the priest. When you enter the  
 Confessional you have the option of kneeling or of sitting face-to-face  
 with the priest. Begin with The Sign of the Cross: In the Name of the  
 Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen. Then say,  
 Bless me Father for I have sinned, it has been (state how long its been  
 since your last Confession). My sins are: (state your sins. When you are  
 through, say, I’m sorry for these sins and the sins of all my life). Listen  
 to what the priest has to say and for your penance. The priest may ask  
 you to pray the *Act of Contrition*. Make the Sign of the Cross with the  
 priest. Then say, Thank you, Father or Thank you, Monsignor. Find a  
 quiet place to pray your penance. If you would like a *Guide to  
 Confession* and an *Aid of Your Examination of Conscience* visit the Reli-  
 gious Education Office or call 455-2267. Leave a message if necessary.

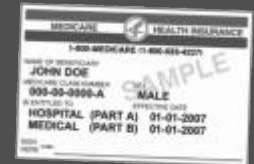
