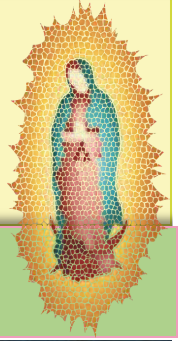

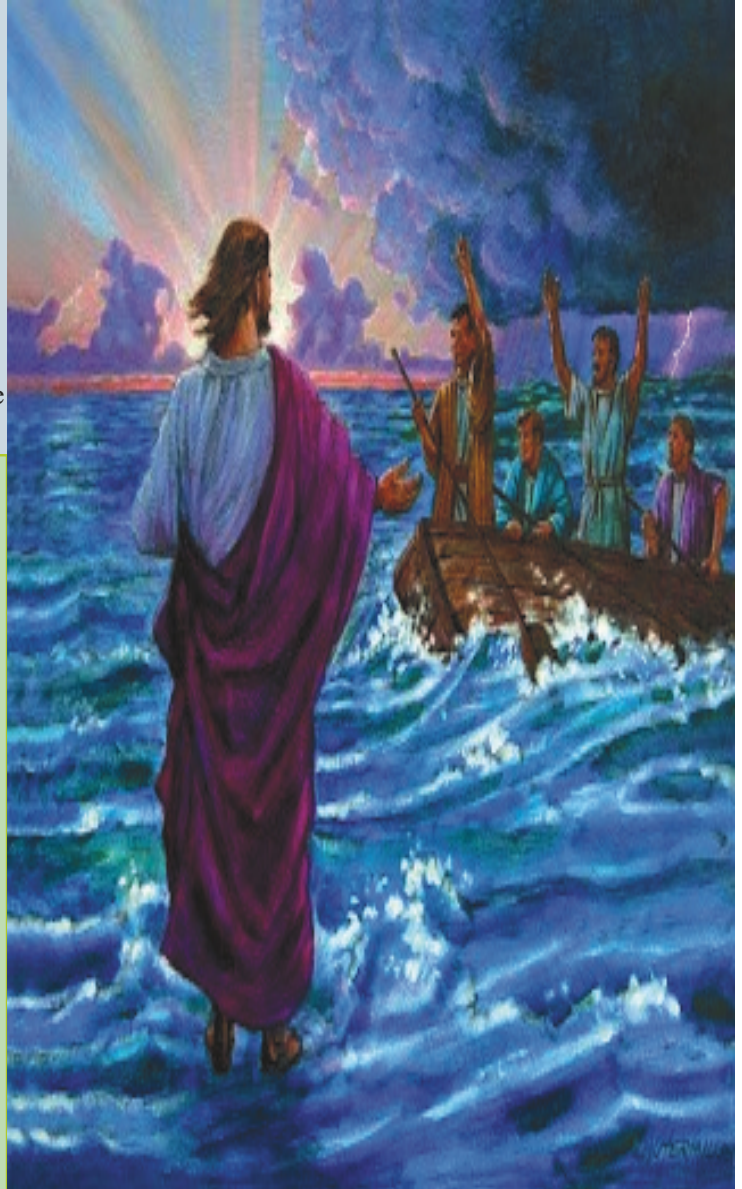

Saint Maximilian Kolbe, Priest & Martyr:

Feast Day: August 14

Patron of: Families, Recovery from Drug Addiction, Prisoners, Journalists, Pro-Life Movement

A Catholic, Polish Priest who gave up his life and volunteered to take someone else's place in the German death camp Auschwitz. He promoted the veneration of the Virgin Mary. He was canonized by Pope John Paul II and was declared a martyr of charity. John Paul II also declared him the "Patron Saint of Our Difficult Century," as 1900-1999 consisted of multiple wars and famine.

Abuse Awareness Training:

Attention all members of various organizations that serve in the church. We are all required to take the online course *Abuse Awareness Training for Adults; Creating a Safe Environment for Our Children Workshop*, sponsored by the Archdiocese of Santa Fe. Visit archdiosf.org; then click Promise to Protect, Pledge to Heal; then click on VIRTUS Online. Then download a certificate of completion and send it to the Parish Office. Workshops are good for five years. If you are not sure if you are up to date, call the Religious Education Office at 455-2267 to check your status.

Spanish Mass will be starting in El Rancho next Saturday. No Reservations are required however, a MASK is Required and MUST cover your mouth and nose. This requirement is for ALL, vaccinated or unvaccinated.
