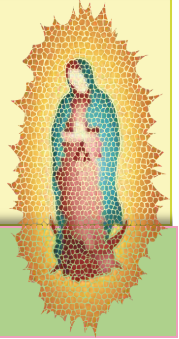

Saint Peter Claver, Priest:

Feast Day: September 9

Patron of: slaves, The Republic of Columbia & ministry to African Americans



Born in 1580, he was a Spanish Jesuit Priest, he was in Columbia during a time when many slaves were entering the country. He became a caretaker for them and would help any who were injured or ill. He also dedicated himself to administering the Sacraments to all slaves who wanted them.

Abuse Awareness Training:

Attention all members of various organizations that serve in the church. We are all required to take the online course *Abuse Awareness Training for Adults; Creating a Safe Environment for Our Children Workshop*, sponsored by the Archdiocese of Santa Fe. Visit archdiosf.org; then click Promise to Protect, Pledge to Heal; then click on VIRTUS Online. Then download a certificate of completion and send it to the Parish Office. Workshops are good for five years. If you are not sure if you are up to date, call the Religious Education Office at 455-2267 to check your status.
