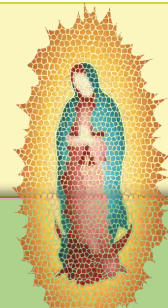

Born in Palestine sometime in the 1st Century, Saint Matthew was one of Jesus’ 12 apostles and also one of the four Evangelists. According to the Bible, Matthew authored the first Gospel of the Bible’s New Testament, now known as the Gospel of Matthew. Prior to preaching the word of God, he worked as a tax collector in Capernaum.

COVID Restrictions still in place:

The Archbishop has let each Pastor make his own COVID restrictions, our Parish will still be enforcing the following:

- Masks are required in all church facilities, for all church events, including Baptisms, Funerals, Masses, Weddings, Adoration and Quinceaneras.
- There is no capacity limit in place, but if possible, we ask that social distancing is still practiced.
- Communion will only be given in the hand and is to be consumed BEFORE you get to your pew. We ask that after receiving, you step to the side, lift your mask and consume, then return to your seat.
