To be a Sponsor for the Sacraments:

Parents seeking sponsors for the sacraments of their offspring should choose exemplary Catholics who practice their faith faithfully, a mentor who will serve as a role model, demonstrating time, talent and treasure, and be a support to the person they are sponsoring. Sponsors/Godparents:

- Must be a Baptized member of the Catholic Church
- Be at least 16 years old
- Have received the Sacraments of Holy Eucharist and Confirmation
- IF married, be married in the Catholic Church; if not married, should not be living with someone as husband and wife
- Should attend mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation and receive the Sacraments of Penance and Holy Communion at least once a year in the Easter Season.
- Understands and accepts these responsibilities. Will assist the parents in their Christian duty, and will help by example, word and action to live as a faithful Christian in communion with, and according to, the teachings of the Holy Catholic Church.

Parents MUST BE in communication with the Parish Office in the process of the completion of paperwork needed to complete sacraments. Paperwork must be completed 2 weeks before the sacraments are received. It is up to the parents to make sure that **all** the necessary paperwork is submitted, prior to baptisms or confirmations.

Updated COVID Restrictions from Archdiocese:

Celebrant/ all ministers: * Vaccinated or weekly testing, If not vaccinated, this should be known to all present for their own decision to attend, and protect themselves and families. * Masks: All but celebrant, lector when reading, cantor when singing. Age 2 and below exempt. Masks required in all church facilities, all church events, Baptisms, Funerals, Masses, Religious Education Classes, Weddings, Adoration & Quinceaneras. * Social Distancing: Highly recommended. * Homily Length: Short is recommended to limit exposure to enclosed-space atmosphere. * Sign of Peace: Optional; suspension recommended. * Communion ministers: Vaccinated and masked, one species in hand only, consume communion immediately by stepping aside and then return to your seat. * Dispensation from attending weekly Mass: Remains; streaming and video recorded/ internet accessible Masses are HIGHLY recommended so as to serve for the homebound or those fearful. * Anointing of the Sick/ Last Rites: At the judgement of the Priest. Should not be given to COVID patients. Pope Francis' dispensation/ indulgence is still in place: Priests need to remember that while it may seem heroically romantic to minister to COVID patients, if they become ill, their parish may be without a Priest. * Other, Non-Religious Education Gatherings: Masks: all, Age 2 and below exempt. * Capacity restriction: Recommended. * Singing: Suspension recommended. Office Staff: Fully Vaccinated or Weekly testing, cards are needed on file.
