Parents seeking sponsors for the sacraments of their offspring should choose exemplary Catholics who practice their faith faithfully, a mentor who will serve as a role model, demonstrating time, talent and treasure, and be a support to the person they are sponsoring. Sponsors/Godparents: Must be a Baptized member of the Catholic Church

- Be at least 16 years old
- Have received the Sacraments of Holy Eucharist and Confirmation
- If married, be married in the Catholic Church; if not married, should not be living with someone as husband and wife
- Should attend mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation and receive the Sacraments of Penance and Holy Communion at least once a year in the Easter Season.
- Understands and accepts these responsibilities. Will assist the parents in their Christian duty, and will help by example, word and action to live as a faithful Christian in communion with, and according to, the teachings of the Holy Catholic Church.

**Parents MUST BE in communication with the Parish Office in the process of the completion of documents required for Sacraments.** Paperwork must be completed two weeks before the sacraments are received. It is up to the parents to make sure that **all** the necessary paperwork is submitted, prior to baptisms or confirmations. For any questions or more information, contact the Parish Office.

**NSDG COVID-19 POLICIES:**

The Archdiocese has given the Parish Priest the discretion to mandate their own COVID-19 Policies. Masks will be **REQUIRED** in all church facilities at **ALL** times. This policy goes for all Priests, Deacons, Lectors, Ushers, Choirs, all Ministries, and the Congregation. If you are at the Altar serving, reading, singing or in a Choir, the mask must remain on at **ALL** times. All ministries who participate must be fully vaccinated with proof of card on file and have taken the Child Protection Training ages 18 and above. ASF Policy: Parish Staff must be fully vaccinated with proof of card on file or adhere to weekly testing. Dispensation from attending Mass remains; Spanish and English Videos are recorded so as to serve for the homebound or those fearful.

**SUNDAY GOSPEL REFLECTION**

**First Reading:** Jesus is taken up to heaven in the presence of the Apostles.

**Responsorial Psalm:** Sing praise to God as he mounts his throne.

**Second Reading:** God raised Jesus from the dead and seated him at his right hand.

**Luke 24:46-53**

**Jesus is taken to heaven and the disciples remain in Jerusalem awaiting his sending of the spirit.**

When Jesus was taken to heaven on the 40th day after Easter, in Cycle C, our Gospel is taken from the conclusion of the Gospel of Luke. There are similarities in the reports of Jesus' Ascension found in the Synoptic Gospels-Mark, Matthew, and Luke. In each account, Jesus assigns his disciple the task of proclaiming the Gospels of Mark and Matthew, the disciples are sent by Jesus to baptize as well as to preach. In Luke's Gospel, however, this commission to baptize is absent. Instead, Jesus directs the disciples to return to Jerusalem to await the fulfillment of his promise to send them the Holy Spirit. Curiously, only Mark and Luke actually report Jesus' Ascension into heaven, Matthew's Gospel concludes with Jesus' promise to remain with his disciples forever. Only the Gospel of Mark notes that Jesus ascended to sit at the right hand of God. In noting this, Mark teaches that Jesus' Ascension affirms the glory Jesus received from God after his death and Resurrection. Those who believe in Jesus will be empowered to do what Jesus himself had done. Already in Mark's Gospel, during his ministry, Jesus sent his disciples out to preach, to heal, and to drive out unclean spirits. Now, they are sent again to do these things and more. From his place with God in heaven, Jesus helped his disciples, and he continues to help us as we try to live as his followers.

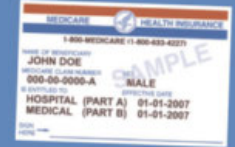
