



REFLECTION OF THE 2ND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY

TIME: The readings for the 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time invite us to hear God calling and to respond. In the First reading, God calls to Samuel and he replies. The psalm speaks of waiting for the Lord and answering. The Gospel tells of the call of the first apostles. These readings highlight the theme of listening. Amid the noise and distraction of our world, we must be aware of becoming more focused on the importance of listening. We must reflect on being still and really hear God clearly, acknowledging that it takes practice and effort to discern His voice amid life's clamor.

FAMILY CONNECTION

In today's Gospel we learn about one of at least two family relations that appear among Jesus' First disciples. Andrew is the brother of Simon, whom Jesus renames Peter. In next week's Gospel, we will learn about the brothers James and John, the sons of Zebedee. We know from the letters of Paul and other witnesses to the early Church that it was a common occurrence for an entire household to be baptized together. From the very beginning of the Church, families helped one another to know and follow Jesus. We hope and pray that this continues to be true in our family life. Gather some items that remind you of your faith. A cross or crucifix displayed in your home, a statue of Mary, or statues or other art depicting saints. This Gospel teaches us how Andrew led Simon to Jesus.

SUNDAY GOSPEL REFLECTION

First Reading: 1 Samuel 3:3b-10,19 The Lord calls Samuel. Responsorial Psalm: 40:2,4,7-8-9,10 A prayer of commitment to follow the will of the Lord.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 6:13c-15a,17-20 Paul reminds the Corinthians that their bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit.

Gospel Reading: John 1:35-42 John the Baptist recognizes Jesus as the Lamb of God, and Jesus receives his first followers.

Although the liturgical season of Ordinary Time begins this week, the reading continues with the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord, which concludes the Christmas season. The Gospel immediately follows John the Baptist's testimony about Jesus and his identification of Jesus as the Lamb of God. Having been baptized by John, Jesus begins to gather followers. The followers sought out Jesus because of the testimony and witness of John the Baptist. We are familiar with the title that John the Baptist uses for Jesus the Lamb of God. We hear it weekly at the fraction rite during Mass. For those who heard John the Baptist, This title recalled key themes from the Old Testament. It alludes to the paschal lamb offered as a sacrifice when God freed the Israelites from slavery in Egypt, the event that is commemorated by the Jewish Passover celebration. The designation recalls the prophet Isaiah's description of the suffering servant of Israel. In using this name for Jesus, John the Baptist predicts Jesus' passion and death and the new interpretation of Passover that will begin with Jesus' Last Supper. In today's reading how Jesus' first followers were gathered. The first two, Andrew and another man, were followers of John the Baptist. After hearing John's testimony, they became followers of Jesus. During their time with Jesus, the details of which are not specified, Andrew and the other follower came to believe that Jesus was the Messiah. Andrew brings his brother, Simon, to Jesus. Immediately, Jesus gave Simon a new name, calling him Peter, which means "rock" in Greek. The renaming of Simon to Peter is reported in all four of the Gospels.
