

#### REFLECTION: TWENTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY

**TIME:** The 20th Sunday reflects on themes of division caused by the Gospel, the importance of being "rich toward God," and the fire of the Holy Spirit. Jesus' message of love and salvation can lead to division, even within families, as some reject his teachings while others embrace them. We are called to prioritize spiritual wealth over material possessions and to allow the Holy Spirit to ignite our hearts, motivating us to share the Gospel with the world. Jesus's message of peace and salvation can cause division, as not everyone will accept his teachings. This division can even extend to families, as some may reject Christ's call while others embrace it. In essence, the 20th Sunday in Ordinary time, Year C, invites us to reflect on the transformative power of the Gospel, the importance of prioritizing spiritual wealth, and the role of the Holy Spirit in our lives. We are called to be faithful disciples of Christ, even in the face of division, and to share the fire of the Holy Spirit with the world.

#### **FAMILY CONNECTION**

Families strive for unity and togetherness. Nobody enjoys occasions when divisions in family life become all to evident. Yet, in this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus says that he has come to bring division and that members of households will be divided. Talk as a family about the things that you do together to bring about family unity (togetherness), such as sharing meals. Going to church together, celebrating special occasions, or sharing family traditions. Explain that all of these things are important and that Jesus wants families to show this kind of love for one another, Sometimes as parents, you have to make decisions that are unpopular with your children. They may divide you in the short run but in the long run it builds deeper unity with your family.

#### SUNDAY GOSPEL REFLECTION

First Reading: Jeremiah 38:-6,8-10 Jeremiah is punished for criticizing the wealthy for their corruption and their injustice to the poor.

**Responsorial Psalm: 40:2-4,18** A prayer for God's help. **Second Reading: Hebrews 12:1-4** Let us persevere in running the race that lies before us while keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus.

Gospel Reading: Luke 12:49-53 Jesus has come not only to bring peace but also division.

Having reminded the apostles and the crowd that facing the coming judgement takes patience, Jesus now goes on to speak of how difficult it will be to wait. He tells them that the has come to set the earth on fire. Recall that in Lukes's Gospel, John the Baptist tells the crowd that he is baptizing with water, but someone mightier is coming who will baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire. The fire Jesus speaks of here is the distress caused by the coming judgement. It is also the fire of the Spirit that Luke, in the Acts of the Apostles, will describe descending on the disciple on Pentecost. That fire will strengthen them to go out to the whole world to preach the good news of Jesus' Resurrection. Jesus will be the first to experience the distress of the coming judgement. His baptism will be the conflict into which he will be immersed as he approaches Jerusalem and his death on the cross. His followers will not be spared that distress. The angels at Jesus' birth proclaimed peace on earth, and Simeon, holding the baby Jesus in the Temple, said to God; "Master, now you may let your servant go in peace." Here Jesus tells the crowd not to think he has come to bring peace," Here Jesus tells the crowd not to think he has come to bring peace; he has come to bring division. Peace is the ultimate end of the Kingdom of God, but peace has a price. Jesus is warning the crowd that wherever the Word of God is heard and acted upon, division occurs. We don't expect to hear such difficult words from Jesus in the Gospel. But it is good to be reminded once in a while that the decision to do the right thing, the good thing, is not always easy and without conflict.
