WELCOME TO THE LITURGY CORNER!

When does the Christmas Season begin, and when does it end? Why?

The liturgical season of Christmas begins with the Vigil

Masses on Christmas Eve (December 24th) and concludes on the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord (the Sunday after the Epiphany of the Lord which is January 12th, 2021 this year). During the Christmas Season, we celebrate the birth of Christ into our world and into our hearts, and reflect on the gift of salvation that is born with Him. It is the feast of the incarnation, the feast of God becoming flesh. It is a uniquely Christian teaching, the Divine choosing to become one of us. Because of this belief, God is not only Transcendent, but also wholly Immanent, Emmanuel (God- with-us). While remaining Transcendent (meaning we must rise above our present condition to reach Him), He is at the same time Immanent (meaning He is with us as we rise toward Him). Pope Francis reminds us, "Christmas is an event which is renewed in every family, parish and community which receives the love of God made incarnate in Jesus Christ. Like Mary, the Church shows to everyone the "sign" of God: the Child whom she bore in her womb and to whom she gave birth, yet who is the Son of the Most High, since he "is of the Holy Spirit" (Mt 1:20). 
