"Beloved: The grace of God has appeared, saving all and training us to reject godless ways and worldly desires and to live temperately, justly, and devoutly in this age, as we await the blessed hope, the appearance of the glory of our great God and savior Jesus Christ..." (Titus 2:11ff) As we come to the end of the Christmas season we end with the baptism of the Lord. Jesus' baptism signals the beginning of His public ministry and offers us a resounding insight into His identity! "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." God the Father's affirmation of Jesus, His Son, indicates to us anew who Jesus is and who we are in Him! Through our baptism, confirmation, and the Eucharist we are incorporated into Jesus through His Church! Now we continue to grow as His followers always with deepening hope and eager expectation. May Ordinary Time be anything but ordinary! May we continue to "live temperately, justly, and devoutly in this age, as we await the blessed hope, the appearance (second coming) of our great God and savior Jesus Christ!

WELCOME TO THE LITURGY CORNER!

As we celebrate this feast of the Baptism of the Lord, we can study His actions at the Jordan River as a powerful example of servant leadership. We see in Jesus a type of leadership that is characterized by humility and leading by example.

Certainly the sinless Savior did not need a baptism of repentance! But Jesus humbly made Himself one with his people to draw us to Him and create a relationship with us so that we would be open to His teachings and influence.

As a servant leader, we also see that Jesus leads by example. He doesn't just tell the people they need to be baptized. He shows them how and does it Himself to teach them. To lead like Jesus, we, too, must "walk the walk" and not just "talk the talk." If we want those we lead to be generous and hard-working, then we must show them how to do this by demonstrating generosity and hard work ourselves.

Immediately after His baptism, we learn of the powerful affirmation of the Father who opens the heavens, sends the Holy Spirit upon Jesus in bodily form and says audibly, "This is my beloved Son with whom I am well-pleased." Let us be filled with gratitude for our amazing God and be reminded that when we are grateful followers of Jesus and servant-leaders in imitation of Him, the Father will be well-pleased with us, too.



Qualified Charitable Donation (QCD)

St. Anthony Catholic Church invites you to make a *Qualified Charitable Donation* (QCD) tax free out of your retirement account if you are over 70 ½ years of age and are required to take distributions. If you have not taken all your Required Minimum Distribution, you can make a direct contribution to a charity. By making a QCD, you will avoid paying income tax on the distribution and the 50% excise tax penalty from the IRS. But this must be done before December 31.
