“No more shall people call you ‘Forsaken,’ or your land ‘Desolate,’ but you shall be called ‘My Delight,’ and your land ‘Espoused.’ For the Lord delights in you and makes your land His spouse. As a young man marries a virgin, your Builder shall marry you; and as a bridegroom rejoices in his bride so shall your God rejoice in you.” (Is. 62:3-5) Today we hear how this great marriage between God and His people, and in a real way with all of humanity, was revealed! Jesus, “revealed His glory” through the miracle at Cana in Galilee. What a marvel! We, you and I, are espoused to God the Father, through Jesus, in the Holy Spirit! Like all spouses we are called to renew our “I do” daily and to respond to God’s love and commitment to us through faithfulness to our permanent commitment made in our baptism. Like all married couples we are also to be fruitful in our proclamation of the Gospel. Let us rejoice that Jesus is the Bridegroom who has married us!

WELCOME TO THE LITURGY CORNER!

What does it mean to be, "One Body in Christ"?

Let's take a look at what the Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches:

790 Believers who respond to God's word and become members of Christ's Body, become intimately united with him: "In that body the life of Christ is communicated to those who believe, and who, through the sacraments, are united in a hidden and real way to Christ in his Passion and glorification." This is especially true of Baptism, which unites us to Christ's death and Resurrection, and the Eucharist, by which "really sharing in the body of the Lord, . . . we are taken up into communion with him and with one another."

791 The body's unity does not do away with the diversity of its members: "In the building up of Christ's Body there is engaged a diversity of members and functions. There is only one Spirit who, according to his own richness and the needs of the ministries, gives his different gifts for the welfare of the Church." The unity of the Mystical Body produces and stimulates charity among the faithful: "From this it follows that if one member suffers anything, all the members suffer with him, and if one member is honored, all the members together rejoice." Finally, the unity of the Mystical Body triumphs over all human divisions: "For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus."

ADORATION RETREAT

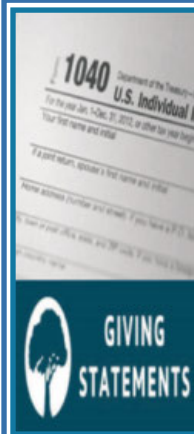

Everyone is welcome to participate in this retreat opportunity on Saturday, January 22nd. Starting at the 8:00am Mass and ending around noon. Food will be provided

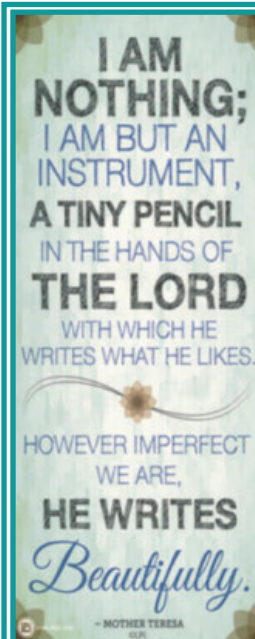

St. Anthony Catholic Church invites you to make a *Qualified Charitable Donation (QCD)* tax free out of your retirement account if you are over 70 ½ years of age and are required to take distributions. If you have not taken all your Required Minimum Distribution, you can make a direct contribution to a charity. By making a QCD, you will avoid paying income tax on the distribution and the 50% excise tax penalty from the IRS. But this must be done before December 31.
