### ANOINTING OF THE SICK

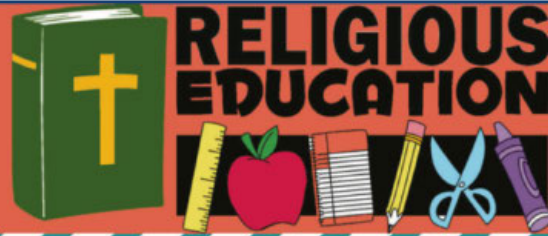
Please telephone the Cathedral office to ask for a priest in case of life-threatening emergencies. Anointings can also be arranged prior to major surgeries.
