

The Jubilee Year was announced earlier by the Holy Father, Pope Francis.

He has chosen as a theme for the Holy Year "Hope Does Not Disappoint".

"Everyone knows what it is to hope. In the heart of each person, hope dwells as the desire and expectation of good things to come, despite our not knowing what the future may bring.

Each Jubilee Year brings with it the opportunity for the faithful to gain a plenary indulgence.

The normal conditions to receive an indulgence are:

- (1) sacramental confession;
- (2) reception of holy communion; and
- (3) prayers for the intention of the Holy Father.

Completion of VIRTUS Training, a Background Check, and Acknowledgement of the Diocesan Code of Conduct are now being done online through the VIRTUS website.

These requirements must be renewed every five years.

New volunteers must create a VIRTUS account and complete the policy requirements before beginning volunteer work. Existing volunteers log in to your account to renew the requirements.
