*Food For Faith Living from the desk of Fr. Mark*

We appreciate and celebrate God's Love each time we gather as the family of God, open our hearts and minds to God's Word and renew ourselves as a united community fed at the Lord's table. We cherish this even as we humbly confess our occasionally taking it for granted. We are grateful and express our thanksgiving in prayer, hymns and ritual symbols and signs. All this is good.

When we open our hearts and minds to God's Word. Subtly, it is fairly easy to lose sight of its' meaning for us because they relate to events of ancient time and circumstances and situations difficult to place in our time and lifestyles. We focus poorly. God's message always pertains to human nature and applies to us if we truly listen.

Jeremiah (1st rd.) paid a heavy price for bringing God's message to people who didn't want to listen . Only when he expressed God's mercy and willingness to heal and restore the people is he free from threats. How easily we embrace what we want to hear and become deaf to what is discomfoting and challenging!

In Hebrews (2nd rd.) the people can embrace the high priest, identified as Jesus, because of the message connected to His priesthood. Jesus has made "sin offerings for the people." Yes, He took our sins upon Himself and we are saved. Of course we give thanks.

The story in today's Gospel is every person's story. A blind man cries out and Jesus hears him. The blind man says: "I want to see." Jesus responds, "Go your way, your faith has saved you." Immediately, he received sight. The meaning? He believed Jesus could do this. In receiving sight, it goes deeper than physical sight. He sees Jesus for Who He is and opens his life to following what Jesus invites all of us to do. To see God's truth, by resisting evil and undoing the injustices inflicted in our midst, which oppress, deny and neglect the rights, needs and care of our suffering sisters and brothers in God's Family. In so doing, we live our thanks, as God requested, by removing the violences in daily life. It is this, and only then, that we can truly celebrate the Eucharist, in unity and peace, as God's family of faith, hope and love.

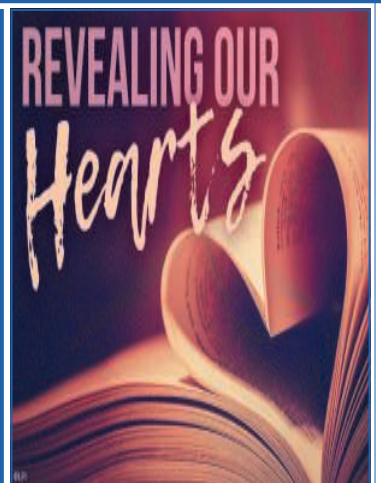
