Food For Faith Living from the desk of Fr. Mark

The feasts of All Saints and All souls, celebrated Nov. 1 and 2, remind us of who we are, sinners who persevere and are destined for the kingdom! These feasts are us, pure and simple. There is no person in heaven who didn't sin just as they made a daily effort to avoid sin. Welcome to the human race! The Beatitudes (Gospel, All Saints) states ideal we aspire to fulfill even as we confess our failures to do so. Perseverance is a true trust in God's mercy. It is undying hope in the face of life's hard realities and our own frailty in deciding between good and bad, right and wrong, fair and unfair, just and unjust, honesty and deceit, forgiveness and vindictiveness, reconciliation and hardness of heart as well as all the either/or choices which make us blessings or curses to each other. A closer and deeper reflection provides us with the root sources of choosing between love and selfishness. When everything revolves around self, the seeds of violating life are planted. Wisdom (1st. rd. All Souls) says it all : "The souls of the just are in the hands of God and no torment shall touch them."

Moses (1st. rd. today) instructs the people in the way to do this. "You shall love the Lord, your God, with, with all your heart, soul and strength and your neighbor as yourself!" We achieve loving God by the way we love each other. This is God's Word, brought fully and completely to life in Jesus Who bids us to "Come, Follow Me."

Hebrews (2nd rd.) reminds us of the priesthood of Jesus lasting forever "because His sacrificial offering is once and for all, " not like the priesthood of mortal men.

St. Mark (Gospel presents a scribe asking Jesus what is the first commandment. Jesus states it, as Moses did, ending with the comment that no other commandment measures up to this. The scribe understands and agrees (do we? do I?) "To love God and others is worth more than all burnt offerings and sacrifices." Jesus commends the scribe: "you are not far from the kingdom of God." The gentle ending to the reading invites us to reflect as well. When Jesus finished, no one dared to ask Him anymore questions. Figure out why?

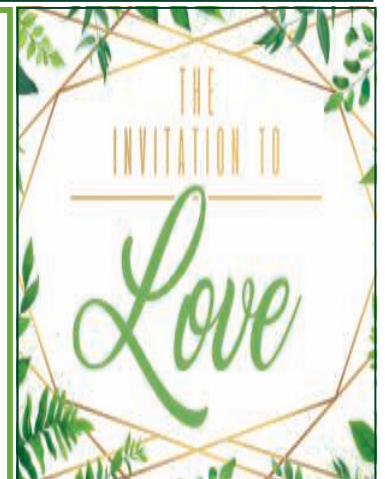
