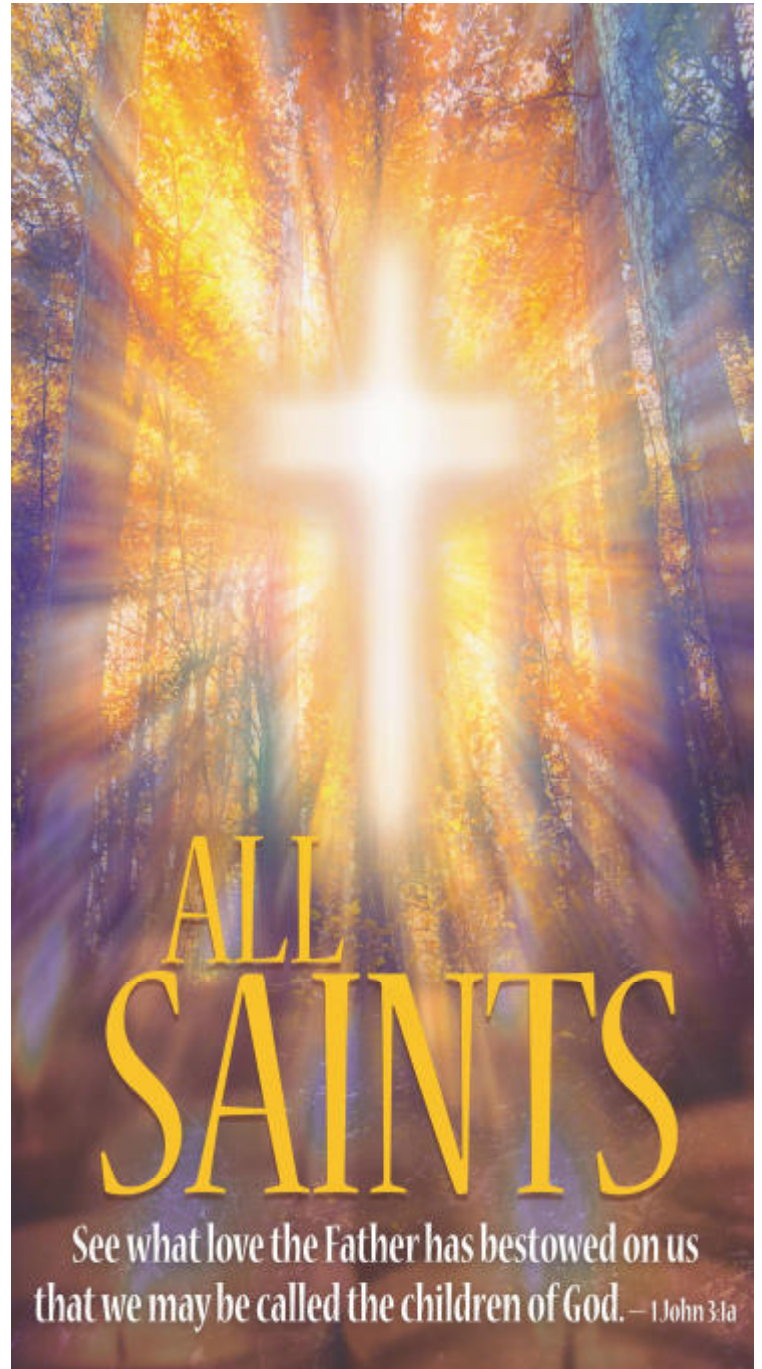

### *Food For Faith Living from the desk of Fr. Mark*

As meaningful as the precious feast of All Saints is, many will be dubious when greeted, "Happy Feast Day!" Humility is a strong virtue enhanced by being the truth. Is doubting in personal sanctity humility or not? We can answer honestly only after discerning what we understand sanctity is. Can't do this until we discern what faith is. Ignorance isn't bliss! This is a chronic problem for every religion. How can people practice and celebrate their faith if they don't grasp its' meaning and purpose?

We belong to the Catholic church which celebrates faith in ritual worship and practices because we've striven to live faith (trust in God) by discerning God's Words of truth, justice, mercy, compassion and purpose. This is a path to fulfillment and an inner joy and peace no one can destroy! It provides us with the means and energy to face life's hardships, challenges, contradictions and surprise which confront everyone.

Quite a statement; it defines a way of life. The rich, elaborate imagery and symbolism, expressed in Revelations (1st rd.) make sense and bring peace to all who have lived their faith and "survived times of great distress and washed their robes clean in the Blood of the Lamb." We understand Jesus is the Lamb and His Blood washed away all sins! We've connected all the dots and respond by heeding the Lamb's Words, teaching and example.

St. John (2nd rd.) confirms God is truth which is Love, telling us, "See what love God has bestowed on us by calling us the children of God. That is who we are! Living as God's children will lead to seeing God!"

The Gospel spells out this lifestyle of faith in the sacred Beatitudes: loving others in communicated in the many ways we relate to each other and all others. We may be in awe of the beauty and holiness found in this lifestyle. Our human condition may give us pause and wonder about doing so. Welcome to the human race! No one gets things right every time and we easily contradict ourselves and hurt each other. That's not the end: we are able to forgive and be forgiven, reconcile and heal, pick ourselves up and try again! Such perseverance will lead to wholeness and holiness, finding our true selves. Saints are sinners who did not give up, ever trusting in God Who tells us, "Do not be afraid! I am with you always!" Doing so gives us every reason to celebrate our faith as we come to the Lord's Table for Communion!

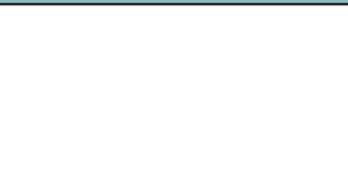
