Food For Faith Living from the desk of Fr. Mark

We come to the end of the church year and, fittingly, celebrate a feast which sums up faith, hope and love. It is to give thanks for God's rule over us, not as a powerful, demanding and vindictive judge, but as the Source of Life, which God is and what Love means. All of history's rulers of empires, nation and kingdoms fall far short of this.

God's rule is Love which embraces God's Mercy, Justice, Compassion and Faithfulness, unconditionally given. It is Love inviting all living beings to sustain the gift of life by sharing it in the many expressions of love which nurture, energize and protect relationships of every kind. The glory of love is its' freedom for love cannot be coerced, manipulated, exploited or self-centered. It is always for the other, be it God, loved ones, communities, society, the whole human family and beyond, all we enjoy in life!

More than likely, none of us comprehend all of this clearly, fully: if we did, we wouldn't be able to contain our joy, peace and thanksgiving! 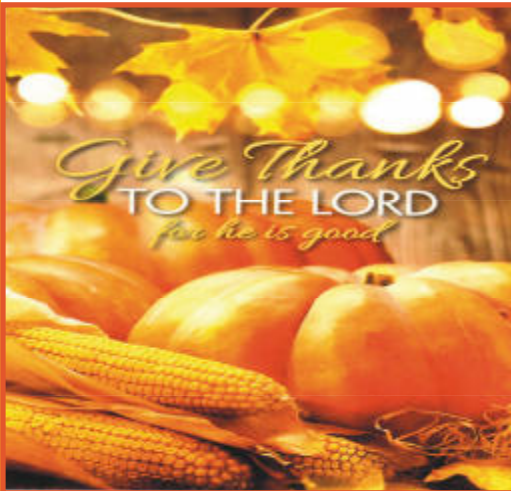

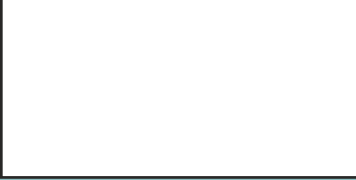
