

Food For Faith Living from the desk of Fr. Mark

The promises of God, in the Hebrew Scripture (Old Testament) sum up the Covenant of God with us. We find this meaning, and God's invitation to respond (faith) in the New testament (2nd rd. and Gospel). This roadmap for our earthly pilgrimage to the Kingdom, is the source of our inner joy and peace by living its' truth and sharing its' love.

Isaiah (1st rd.) contains the fullness of the Promise in theses life-giving verses. "All you who are thirsty, come to the water! Heed Me, and you shall delight in rich fare. Listen, that you may have life in this eternal covenant! As high as the heavens are above the earth, are My thoughts above your thoughts! So shall My Word be and will not return to Me void, but shall achieve the end for which I sent it!"

All this, and the ways to understand and live it, follow as Jesus proclaims the Good News! In John (2nd rd.) "everyone who believes Jesus is the Christ, is begotten by God and conquers the world. For the love of God is this: that we keep God's commandments and believe that Jesus is the Son of God Who testifies to God's Truth fully!"

The Gospel confirms this. Matthew recalls John, the Baptist, proclaiming, "He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit!" We come full circle, to a living faith, symbolized by our Baptism, but founded upon, rooted in and sincerely expressed when we heed God's Word! As Jesus is baptized by the Baptist, "The Spirit comes upon Him and a voice comes from the heavens declaring, "You are My Beloved Son!" and God's request, "listen to Him!" Doing so is our faith response. Jesus sums up all the ways we relate to his teachings, healings and compassion with "Love one another as I love you!" The Holy Spirit enlighten us to the ways we do this faithfully that are found in relating to, and depending upon, each other, all others, and all of creation! The humble, bottom line, reality? We are free to decide for ourselves! This is true freedom which sets us free!


