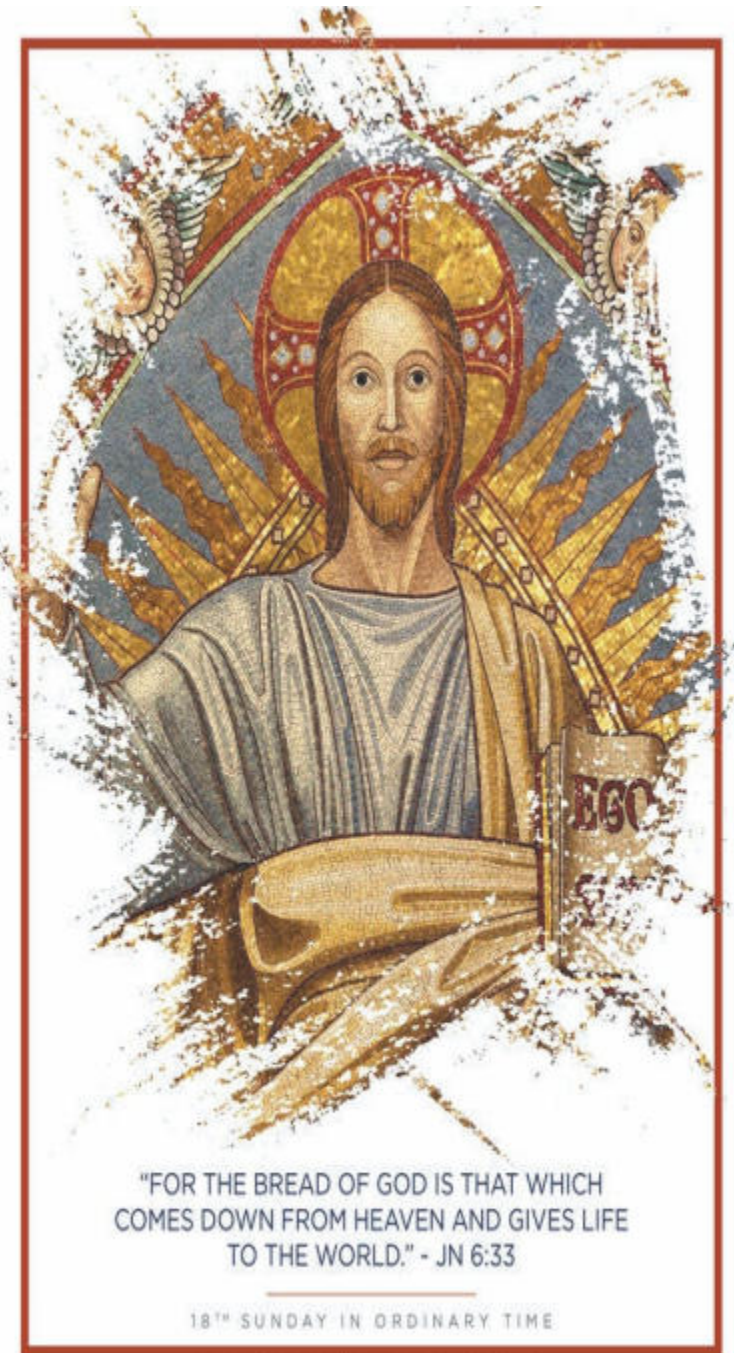

# Please Remember Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church in Your Will

FOOD FOR FAITH LIVING FROM THE DESK OF FR. MARK

Self-serving desires fill today's readings. They are in conflict with God's truth, our freedom. The people, liberated from slavery in Egypt, soon complain about their hunger (1st rd.) while crossing the desert. God feeds them, but in an unusual way. They are called to trust in God. Will they? Will we?

No grumbling from the crowd Jesus fed (Gospel). They seek Him out, Not "to seek food that endures for eternal life (God's truth), but for food that perishes." Jesus conveys this truth today: "I am the bread of life; Whoever comes to Me will never hunger and whoever believes in Me will never thirst!" This appeals to our senses; it becomes a challenge when Jesus invites us to discern its' meaning being revealed in His teaching, healing, compassion, mercy and giving of Self to all. To have this food and drink is to understand its' life-giving source is love. To give life to each other is to have life without end. Love is the source of life, is relational, giving itself to others. It is not a quantity which runs out. It replenishes the giver as well as blesses the other. This is a treasure no one can take away.

The truth also reveals the chaos and calamities of life, the results of choosing selfishness, self-seeking and hoarding life for "me and mine" alone. It is lifeless, a vacuum, a choice for the empty and false treasures of wealth, power, control and security which initiate the endless flow of injustices heaping misery, poverty, suffering and hardships on all who bear the weight inflicted.

The tragedy of this ugly, on-going reality, is the justifications people convince themselves of in disregarding God's Truth. It becomes the self-righteous attitude and arrogance found in religions and the secular world, a sense of being superior to and better than all others. Ugly images, are they true? Dare we do some soul-searching and discern their presence in racism, white privilege, if not supremacy. Do we close our eyes and hearts to the denial of rights to our fellow humans, demeaning their dignity and respect due them as God's children and being stone deaf and hearted to their cries for help in their dire needs in the face of over abundance among us? Only God's truth can free us to come together, work together, co-operate together for the well-being of everyone and the common good of all. Do I believe?

After the revolution of 1917, Russia became an emblem of the Communist era, a land without churches and without God. Under Stalin, all Catholic Churches were confiscated and Dioceses closed. Most churches were desecrated or destroyed. Catholics were murdered by the hundreds of thousands and their bodies dumped into mass grave.
