FOOD FOR FAITH LIVING FROM THE DESK OF FR. MARK

The story of salvation is the revelation of God's love and actions which fill the Scriptures with meaning, a purpose bringing joy and peace to all who embrace it with thanksgiving and live it in life-giving relationships. The Assumption of Mary celebrates these truths resulting in eternal life. It is love's victory over sin and evil, the demise of death's power and intent to destroy life. That death and sin are removed forever is the truth which sets us free, the truth we are invited to live and give to each other and all of life, in being faithful to the Covenant God established with the human family.

The model for, and exemplary example of, faithfulness to embracing God's Word, is Mary. In the ever unexpected ways of God, Who is full of surprises, Mary is the Ark of the Covenant, with her "Yes" to God bringing God's life to us with the birth of Jesus, God joining us as a human person. There is much charm, beauty and sacredness to be enjoyed in reflecting on Love Personified. Mary rejoiced in it, remaining faithful in the face of hardships, fears. Suffering and sorrows, the realities in her life, the ugly reminders of sin and evil's capacities to mar beauty, injure sacredness and peace. These realities are true as Love Personified (Jesus) willingly endured a brutal death. Yet, His death destroyed death forever, confirming that life is the source of life unto unending, eternal life which Mary passes into without delays.

For some, This reads like a fairytale of "living happily ever after" joy and peace. God's truths bring us ever back to the realities we face. It is in remaining faithful to God's Word that we come to understand St. Paul (2nd rd.) saying "Death is swallowed up" and God's Promise fulfilled. Mary expressed it beautifully, in the Magnificat, rejoicing in the great acts of God to her and all people who follow her example. As Jesus said (Gospel) to the people who praised "the womb that carried You and the breasts at which You nursed," "Blessed are they (us) who hear the Word of God and observe it!" God's Word will not return to God void! Our thanks giving is expressed in living it daily, and celebrating it together in the Eucharist! God's Spirit has set us truly free!

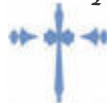

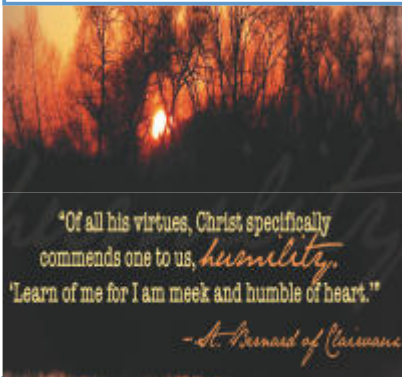
