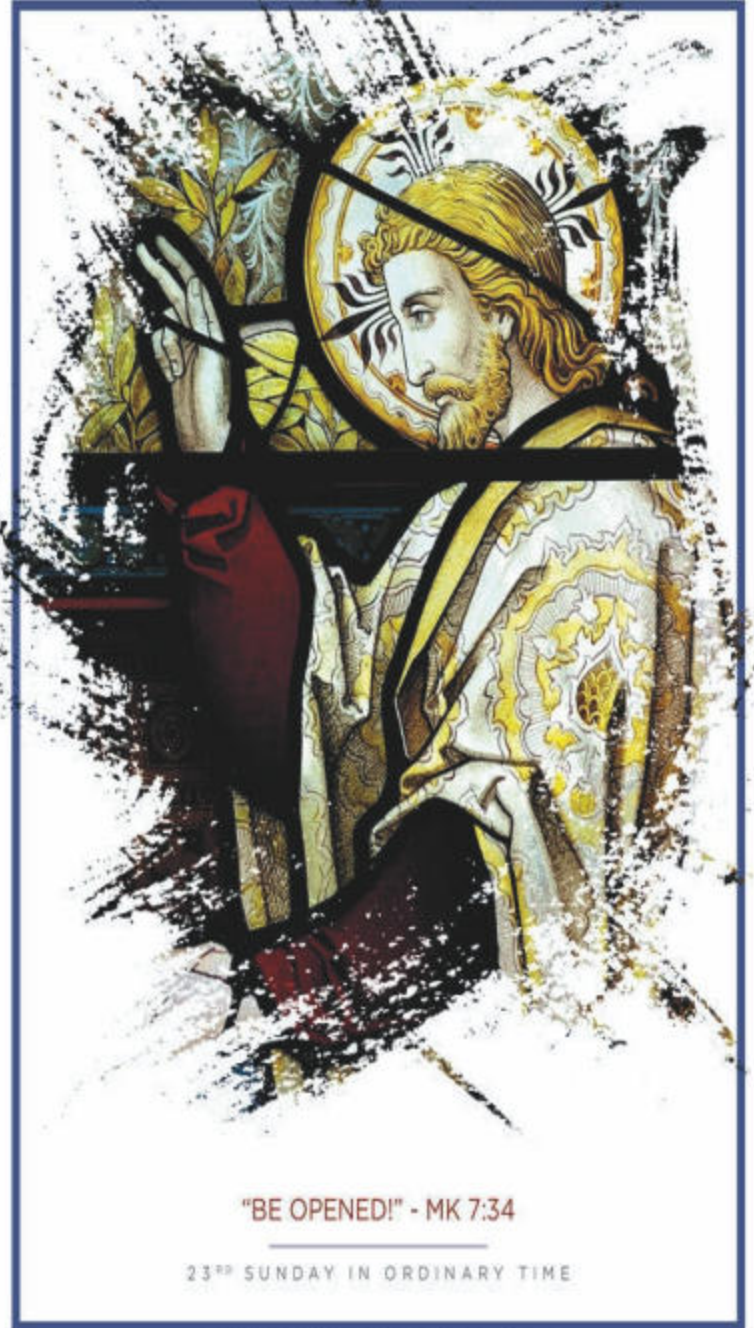

FOOD FOR FAITH LIVING FROM THE DESK OF FR. MARK

In Isaiah (1st rd.) the people, living in captivity, are given hope. Given the complexities in life, a world connected by instantaneous news reaching everywhere, people need God's message to "all people who are frightened. Be strong, fear not! Here is your God Who comes with vindication!" In chaotic, dysfunctional times, people hunger for reassurance that conditions will improve and some normalcy return. We hunger for this, but hopelessness slips in when no signs of light occur.

God's Word will be fulfilled and the promise too. Such is the faith of persons who discern its' meaning. God's Word is an invitation to all, intimately personal and definitely communal. The bottom line truth? It will happen when people understand and accept their contribution and participation in achieving it. This is God's Truth setting us free. We've found life's meaning and purpose! We freely choose to love others and all of creation as God loves us. God is the Source of Life and Love its' identification! The truly free enter into living this truth by their giving of self to each other in all of the wondrous expressions of love, each life-giving, sustaining, restoring and fulfilling!

St. James (2nd rd.) presents the blind spot we easily trip over and hurt self and others by. To love "is to have no partiality." How often we are partial and preferential in loving! To loved ones and to the rich and influential, to those who have much and seek more? It is sub-conscious: we admire them as better, smarter and more deserving than the poor, weak and powerless people in our midst. Is it that we aspire to be like them, that our hunger for security, comfort, control and admiration of others distorts our focus on being who and what God invites and desires us to be? Achieving such comforts is a blessing neither wrong nor harmful. They become curses when they are life's goals, a choice to hoard life for self, for me and mine only. Ugly images? True realities?

The Word of God requires listening and discerning. We are spiritually deaf to God's Truth when we hear it, mouth it and, then, ignore it, disregarding its' meaning. In the Gospel, Jesus "opens the ears of the deaf,," His purpose is, essentially and ultimately, spiritual, to open our hearts, minds and will to love, which is life's on-going source onto life eternal. Do I believe? What is God saying to me? It begins with, "peace be with you and do not be afraid." God's invitation to love others is the path to fulfilment here... and forever!

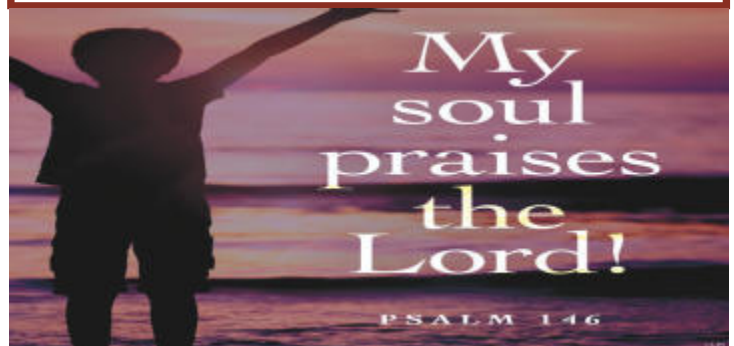
