FOOD FOR FAITH LIVING FROM THE DESK OF FR. MARK

Today's presentations sound contemporary, easily identified in our dysfunctional society for anyone making an effort and get involved in discerning truths and facts from the superficial views, opinions, fantasies, and biases being expressed in media forms people now rely on for information.

Wisdom (1st rd.) stereotypes the just and wicked in stark terms, at opposite poles in how we live. The wicked plot to undo all that the just seek and work for. They are blatant villains and, the just, heroes. It's not that simple to identify either group in today's fast-paced culture, lifestyles or people's priorities and goals.

St. James (2nd rd.) shoots straight in challenging people to have courage and honesty when soul-searching into the how and why of their attitude, motivation and behavior. Selfishness, in all of its' forms, injures relationships, disrupts communities, deterring entire societies from their focus for bettering life and all people being treated with the dignity and respect they deserve when rights of all are sought, protected and defended. Ugly realities confront us with the truth, ever needing solutions. Selfishness is an ugly reality. When unshackled and free to continue, will dismantle democracy and all the ideals of working together, co-operating for the common good of all. This is a secular way of expressing God's truth that loving others is the freedom bringing everyone fulfillment in our lives.

Jesus (Gospel) tells as unwelcome truth: He will be killed! The disciples can't believe this! He is the True Messiah and following Him leads them to misunderstand what that means. "They argued, amongst themselves, who is the greatest?" Jesus deflates their balloon of fame and fortune. "Anyone wanting to be first, must be last and servant of all!" He chooses a simple example: "Accepting a child, in My name, is accepting Me and whoever receives Me receives the One (God) Who sent Me!" Such is true faith, to trust in a loving, merciful God and not be afraid to live God's truth.

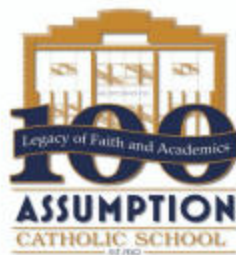
