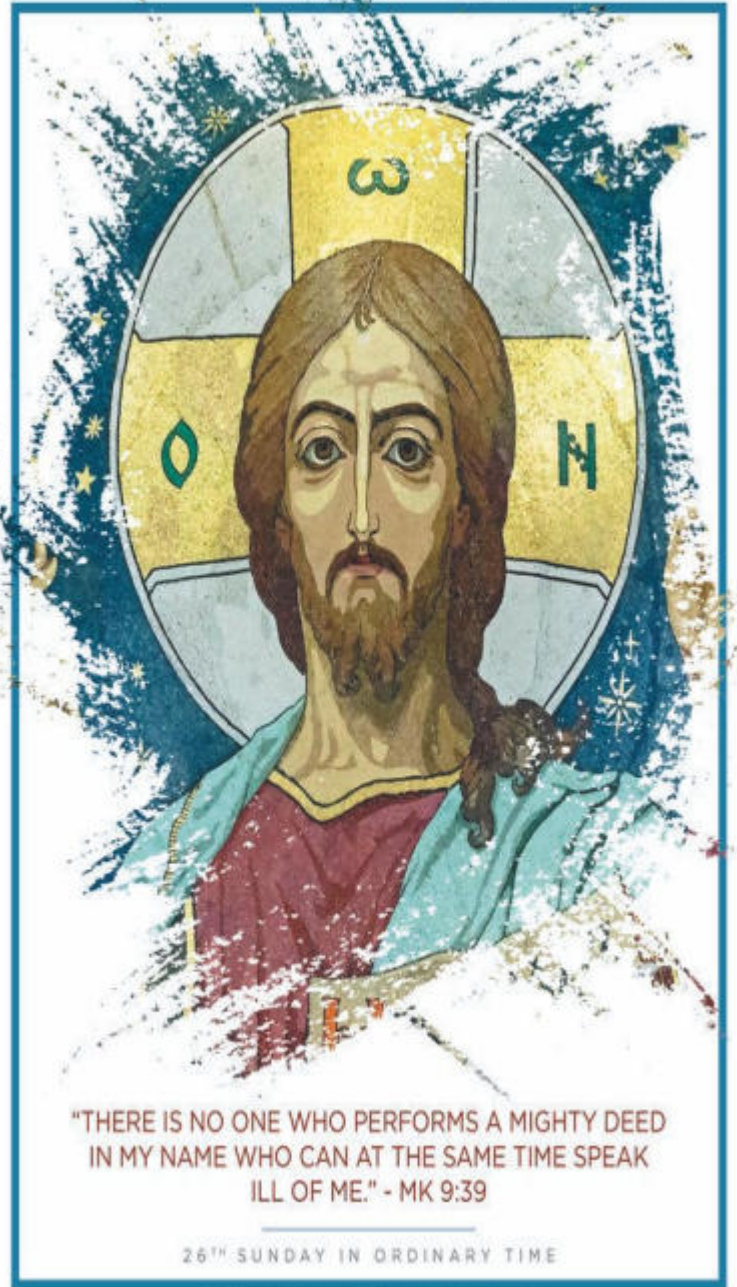

FOOD FOR FAITH LIVING FROM THE DESK OF FR. MARK

Our uniqueness, as persons, is a mystery and God's invitation to express it for the good of others. God desires us to enjoy being unique, but we have the freedom to decide for self how we will live. God promises fulfillment for those who trust in God's Word. This trust invites the Spirit to enlighten, energize and inspire us to find our true selves, a hunger we desire to satisfy. It's the Mystery of God in us without controlling or coercing us. God is Love and loving others is a free choice or it isn't love.

We discover, appreciate and live this truth in many ways. Numbers (1st rd.) presents one: The Spirit fills the elders, working with Moses, and two elders who are absent. The two do God's work and Moses rejoices in the mysterious ways of God.

The Gospel presents another clear example. People are doing what God asks and are not followers of Jesus. He is delighted; "Whoever does what is right and just is for Him because they are doing God's Will! Then, a warning: Whoever causes others to sin, will be punished," and offers a stark example: "If your hand, foot, eye, causes you to sin, cut them off! Better for you to enter the kingdom of God, minus them, than to go into eternal punishment with them!

These ancient views an understanding of life, body and how to live, seem archaic and unreal since people have progressed greatly in knowledge of our humanness and wondrous capacities! St. James (2nd rd.) ever practical and honest, brings a clear focus to God's meaning. The pursuit of wealth, possessions, power, pleasure and control of life is a human desire. When it becomes a person's goal and fulfillment, they will diminish, corrode and even remove a person's willingness, much less desire, to heed God's Word and find our treasure in sharing love, mercy, justice, compassion, forgiveness and generosity with others. It is to give thanks for all the life-giving blessings and gifts God has bestowed on us, God's generosity and faithfulness as life-giver, healer and fulfiller. It reverts back to our free choice to do likewise or not. Do I believe this? May the Spirit inspire us in deciding. Don't be afraid to do so.

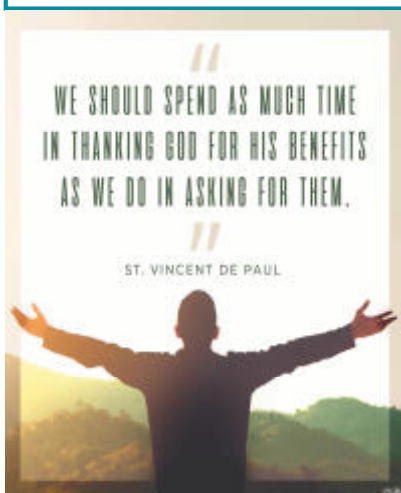
