

FOOD FOR FAITH LIVING FROM THE DESK OF FR. MARK

The truth of our salvation is crammed into the feast day we celebrate, rejoice in and give thanks for as we renew the Covenant with God by "living the truth that sets us free!" This truth set Abraham, the patriarchs, Moses, the prophets and King David free, bringing God's Love and Promise to fruition. This ongoing fulfillment we contribute to by our faithfulness to the Covenant leading to eternal life!

To discern this is to desire to live "in the Light Which dispels the darkness." Isaiah (1st rd.) revealed to us by the Holy Spirit." St. Paul (2nd rd.) states, "the Spirit enlightens us" to its' meaning and inspires us to its' purpose, to live in the truth setting us free!

The chaotic times we live in is a powerful description of our darkness, human freedom used poorly and justified by unchecked misconceptions of rights, freedom and responsibility for our acts. It's easy to ignore, reject or be indifferent to these realities by saying they are not part of God's Word, confining it to church, religion and home life. 


