


**FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

Most of us are quiet people who desire to live a good and holy life, promote the values and mission of the Gospel as best we can, and desire to inherit the gift of life eternal God promises one day. We are a people who want to do the heed God's will. There are others who left us a profound impact along the way: St. Teresa of Calcutta, Dorothy Day, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., St. Angela Merici, Thomas Merton, Mahatma Gandhi, and many others. They left lasting impacts and legacies. Like Moses, they show us by word and deed who God is and what integrity in life looks like. They show us how to be holy by listening to God's Word. In turn, they left behind hope and an unique example of living justly.

We do not need to do what they did or even mirror their relationship with God. Each one of us is God's special creation, with a purpose whose soul is known unto God. For our part, we learn how to open up and bring our souls to fullness of life—without compromise. It is clear when someone is authentic, because they always point to truth; and even though they themselves struggle and sin, they embody a timeless wisdom that we critically intuit is right. In its fullness, Jesus taught with this authority and it astonished many who listened. Power was not used to manipulate or control. It was used to heal.

St. Oscar Romero was another amazing Moses-like figure, who saw God in the burning flame of the Gospel. His faith set out to protect the poorest of the poor, those with no voice to cry out for the right to life. He challenged the evils of his society, and eventually, was tireless and persistent in this work. He must have gotten very close to the problem because it cost him his life. St. Romero said, "When we leave Mass, we ought to go out the way Moses descended Mt Sinai: with his face shining, with his heart brave and strong to face the world's difficulties."

We can learn from this wisdom. If we allow the power of the Mass to transform our inner self, we will leave that holy encounter changed. Our faces will radiate, and we will have courage to bring what we have



received to life's challenges. That sounds doable, doesn't it? Because of the example of our simple holiness, people will be amazed.

**PROCEDURES FOR ATTENDING MASS**

Visit [ctkevergreen.com](http://ctkevergreen.com) and scroll down to register. Sign up weekly from Sunday at noon until noon on Friday. Sign-ups are done each week on a first-come, first-served basis. When all the available slots have been filled, the site closes. The required limit follows local guidelines. Safe distancing face coverings and are required indoors. **Thank you for cancelling if your plans change or if you don't feel well, so that all will be safe and others may attend.**

**MASS ATTENDANCE IN HALL IS FOR High-Risk ATTENDANCE ONLY: (Underlying Medical Conditions or 85 yrs or older)**

- Sign up weekly (from Noon/Sunday until Noon/Friday) for either the 8:00 or 10:00 in the parish hall.
- Visit [ctkevergreen.com](http://ctkevergreen.com) to access SignUpGenius, or call the Parish Office (303-674-3155) if you do not have access to the internet. Sign up weekly Sunday-Friday.
- As in the church, masks must cover **both** face and nose.
- Reminder: this sign up is **only** for those individuals and their family members that are considered high-risk according to the CDC. Mass will be broadcast in the parish hall and the Eucharist will be brought to you at Communion time.




**ASH WEDNESDAY: FEBRUARY 17**


